CDBG (Community Development Block Grant) – We are pleased to announce the City of Miller has been notified we have been awarded the full amount requested of \$790,000 to help fund our water project. \$40,000 will go to the grant administrator (SMCOG) and \$750,000 will go towards construction cost.
