**Secon Sunday of Easter
Segundo Domingo De Pascua**

This Sunday's readings remind us that faith is not about having all the answers, but about being open, even in moments of doubt. Thomas the Apostle shows us that questioning can lead to a deeper, more personal encounter with Christ. The early Christian community lived with unity, generosity, and trust, revealing a way of life shaped by God's love. Their example challenges us to question selfishness and instead choose compassion and shared care for. When we live this way, we begin to reflect God's presence to those around us. We are also reminded to give thanks and trust that God's love endures, even when life feels uncertain. Our faith may be tested at times, but these struggles can strengthen and refine what we believe. Doubt is not something to fear, but something God can use to draw us closer to truth. May we have the courage to ask, to seek, and to believe more deeply each day.

Las lecturas de este domingo nos recuerdan que la fe no se trata de tener todas las respuestas, sino de estar abiertos, incluso en momentos de duda. Thomas the Apostle nos muestra que cuestionar puede llevar a un encuentro más profundo y personal con Cristo. La primera comunidad cristiana vivía con unidad, generosidad y confianza, mostrando un estilo de vida marcado por el amor de Dios. Su ejemplo nos desafía a cuestionar el egoísmo y a elegir la compasión y el cuidado mutuo. Cuando vivimos así, comenzamos a reflejar la presencia de Dios a quienes nos rodean. También se nos recuerda dar gracias y confiar en que el amor de Dios permanece, incluso cuando la vida se siente incierta. Nuestra fe puede ser puesta a prueba en ocasiones, pero esas dificultades pueden fortalecer y purificar lo que creemos. La duda no es algo que debamos temer, sino algo que Dios puede usar para acercarnos más a la verdad. Que tengamos el valor de preguntar, de buscar y de creer más profundamente cada día.

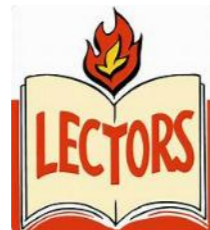
