Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time Cuarto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

In today's readings, it reminds us that prophets in the Old Testament never sought to be prophets. One does not choose to be a prophet. Instead, prophets are called by God. His message was about discernment. What he made me ponder was the significant difference between passionately speaking about something important to you, versus receiving a prophetic message from God. Sometimes, for religious people, these can get confused. We're passionate about many issues, perhaps something rooted in Catholic social teaching, so we speak out strongly and with great confidence... and that can be good. However, sometimes we are tempted to say we're using a "prophetic voice." We should stop and ponder not only our motivations but how we say what we are saying. If it's not deeply rooted in the scriptures, We need to pray and ponder more before speaking



Sitting Before the Priest Sits

In the Mass, the celebrating priest represents Christ (persona Christi), and it is inappropriate for the congregation to sit before he

Making the Sign of the Cross Repeatedly in the Mass

Many Catholics mistakenly make the sign of the cross repeatedly during Mass, especially after receiving Holy Communion, which is incorrect. The sign of the Cross is made only at the beginning and at the end of the Mass.

Genuflecting with the Left Knee

During the Passion of Christ, Roman soldiers knelt with their left knee to Jesus in mockery. Catholics genuflect with their right knee as a sign of respect to the Holy Eucharist. Some Catholics mistakenly genuflect with their left knee, which is incorrect.

Meeting the Priest for Blessings Immediately After the Mass The priest already pronounces blessings at the Concluding Rite just before the end of the Mass. There is no need to meet him for personal blessings after he has recessed out of the Church.

Leaving the Church Before the Priest

Wait for the priest to completely recess out of the Church before following suit.
