Message from the Pastors:

Our concept of gratitude and thanks takes all of us back to a banquet served in 1621 at Plymouth Rock. That celebration was held to commemorate the survival of those Pilgrims through an arduous trip overseas, plague after plague, and that first winter, which claimed almost two-thirds of those who reached the new land. It generated the tradition that every year in our country, we should celebrate a day of thanks for the blessings we receive.

However, we do not have the patent on this practice. For the ancient Jewish race held not one, not two, but three separate Feasts of Thanksgiving. They included the Feast of First Fruits, the Feast of Weeks (Pentecost) and the Feast of Tabernacles. In all of them, they gave praise to God for his provision and bountiful harvest.

But then something changed. Jesus came and turned the world upside down, including how we give thanks. Since all the underlying purposes for those Jewish feast days were fulfilled in the Messiah, there was no need to establish set days to display outwardly our gratitude. It became an internal process.

Likewise, our method of giving thanks as believers changed as well. While we all celebrate the national holiday of Thanksgiving, offering gratitude to God is not strictly an annual event. It is a daily, intentional act of acknowledging God's presence, His purpose, His protection, His provision, and the peace that can only come from Him.

Paul, in his letter to the Thessalonians, states it very clearly for us: 'in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.' (Chapter 5, verse 18). In Christ, we have reason and opportunity to express our thanks to God for all things at all times. The reason: He is our Savior and Redeemer, and we owe Him our life - our eternal life. The opportunity: particularly for us in this nation, we can openly express our praise and gratitude to the one King of Kings. In that alone, we should be thankful.

So does that mean we no longer have to celebrate a traditional day of Thanksgiving with all its food, fun, fellowship, and football? That is not what it means at all. But what it does present for us is yet another reminder of giving thanks on that day, along with every other day of the year!!
