



At the regular meeting of August 20, 2025 Council elected Councillor Shawn Jackson to fill the vacancy in the Mayor's Seat and declared his Council seat vacant, effective August 20, 2025.

The Municipal Act, S.O. 2001 C.25 states that when the seat of a member becomes vacant during term of office, Council may fill a vacancy by appointing a person with a Call for Nomination. Council has decided to appoint a member through a Call for Nomination.

A Call for Nomination is a self-nomination process where a qualified elector in the Village of Sundridge can complete the application form and submit their name for consideration by Council. There is a detailed Council Vacancy Procedure outlined on our website www.sundridge.ca Please read for important dates and processes.

Eligibility Requirements

Any individual filling a vacancy must meet the eligibility requirements of office as outlined in the Act and the Municipal Elections Act as an eligible elector.

A candidate for office must be:

18 years of age or older

A Canadian citizen

A resident of The Village of Sundridge, or an owner or tenant of land in the Village or the spouse of such, and not prohibited from voting under any other Act or disqualified from holding municipal office.

Interested candidates must complete a Council Vacancy Application Form along with the Declaration of Qualification section, provide a piece of identification and proof of address eligibility when submitting in person to the Municipal Office prior to Friday September 5, 2025 at 12:00 pm.

Each nominee may submit a one-page personal statement as well. As part of a Regular Council Meeting, being held on September 10, 2025, each nominee will present to Council and questions of the nominee will be asked so that Council can vote on who they wish to appoint.
