Monument Selection Guide

Choosing a headstone is one of the most meaningful steps in honoring a loved one's life. Some families plan ahead, while others decide after a loss. Either way, take your time. A headstone is more than stone—it's a legacy of love and memory.

When designing a memorial, many families reflect on:

- Faith and Belief** – Spiritual values, scripture, or symbols that held meaning.
- Interests and Hobbies** – Passions, pastimes, and joys that brought life to their days.
- Accomplishments** – Milestones, education, military or personal achievements that defined a life well lived.
- Character and Traits** – The qualities - kindness, humor, strength - that people will always remember.
- Social and Civic Contributions** – Ways they served, gave back, or made a difference in their community.
- Work** – A life's calling, career, or dedication to the land, craft, or service that gave purpose.
- Recipes/Personal Saying** – A favorite recipe, or a classic saying that will remind you of the person being memorialized.

By reflecting on these areas, you can design a memorial that is deeply personal - one that tells a story and preserves memories for generations to come.

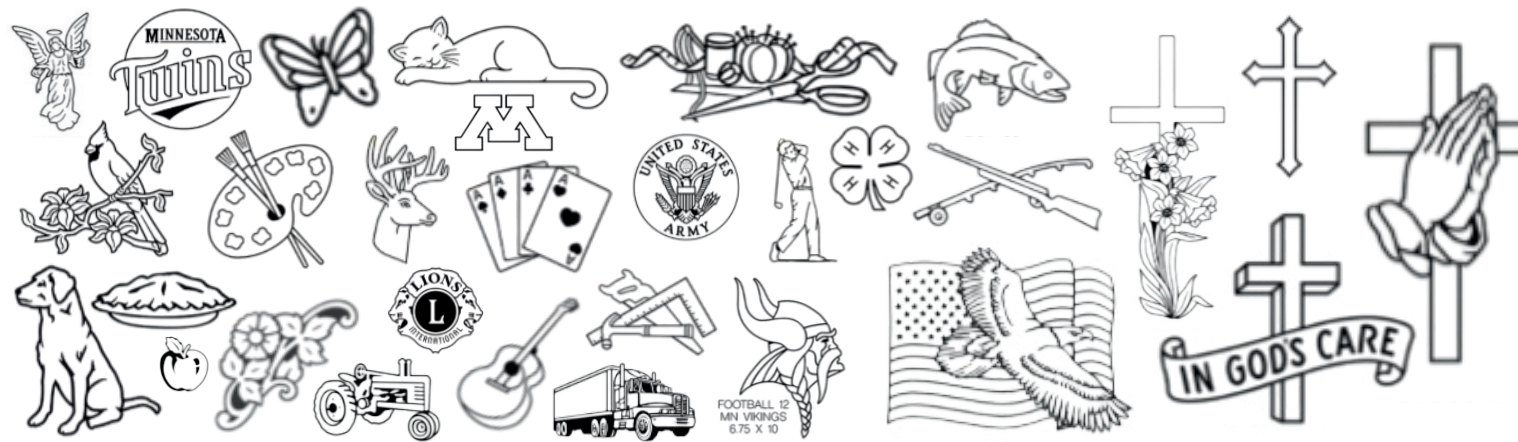
