

Porirua Club Sports Tipping Rules

LENGTH AND DATES

- The competition runs for 15 weeks, with eight games drawn each week.
- The competition starts Monday, 23RD February 2026, the date that the first picks will be available.
- After the final game, the competition concludes **on Sunday, 14th June 2026**
- Prize giving will be on the first Friday at the conclusion of the rounds.

HOW TO PLAY

- Each player has eight game options to pick the winning team or a draw or answer a yes/no question regarding a game.
- Players are to place their weekly Picks in the Sports Tipping box provided or submitted online (where available) by the start of the first game on Fridays for that week's picks.
- Games chosen will cover a variety of sports, including but not limited to Super Rugby, Rugby League, Basketball, Soccer, Netball, and more.
- The games chosen for each week's picks will be played and concluded between 6:00 pm Friday and early Monday morning
- Entries will be scored the following Monday, with scores entered onto the Sports Tipping Score Sheet on the noticeboard, except when the Monday falls on a public holiday.
- New picks will be out each Monday other than when the Monday falls on a public holiday.

POINTS

- Results will be dependent on the score after the game.
- Players will receive one point for each correct game, an additional 2 points if all eight games are correct, and 3 points for any correctly picked draw, excluding soccer.
- Any player who does not submit their picks will receive the lowest score from submitted picks for that week.
- Should a game be abandoned, and there is no result, everyone will be awarded 1 point for that game.

PRIZES

- Cash prizes will be awarded to the top 5 tippers at the conclusion of the 12 weeks.
- Last place wins back their \$20 fee, but to qualify, cannot miss more than three weeks of putting in their picks
- Prize values are determined once the extent of the entry pool is known.
- Should there be more than one winner per cash prize, the prize pool will be combined and divided equally.
- That is, if there are two winners, prize pool one and two are combined and split evenly, three or more winners, the total cash prize is split evenly, etc.
- All prizes are awarded at prize giving.
- The organisers' decisions are final, and no correspondence shall be entered into.
