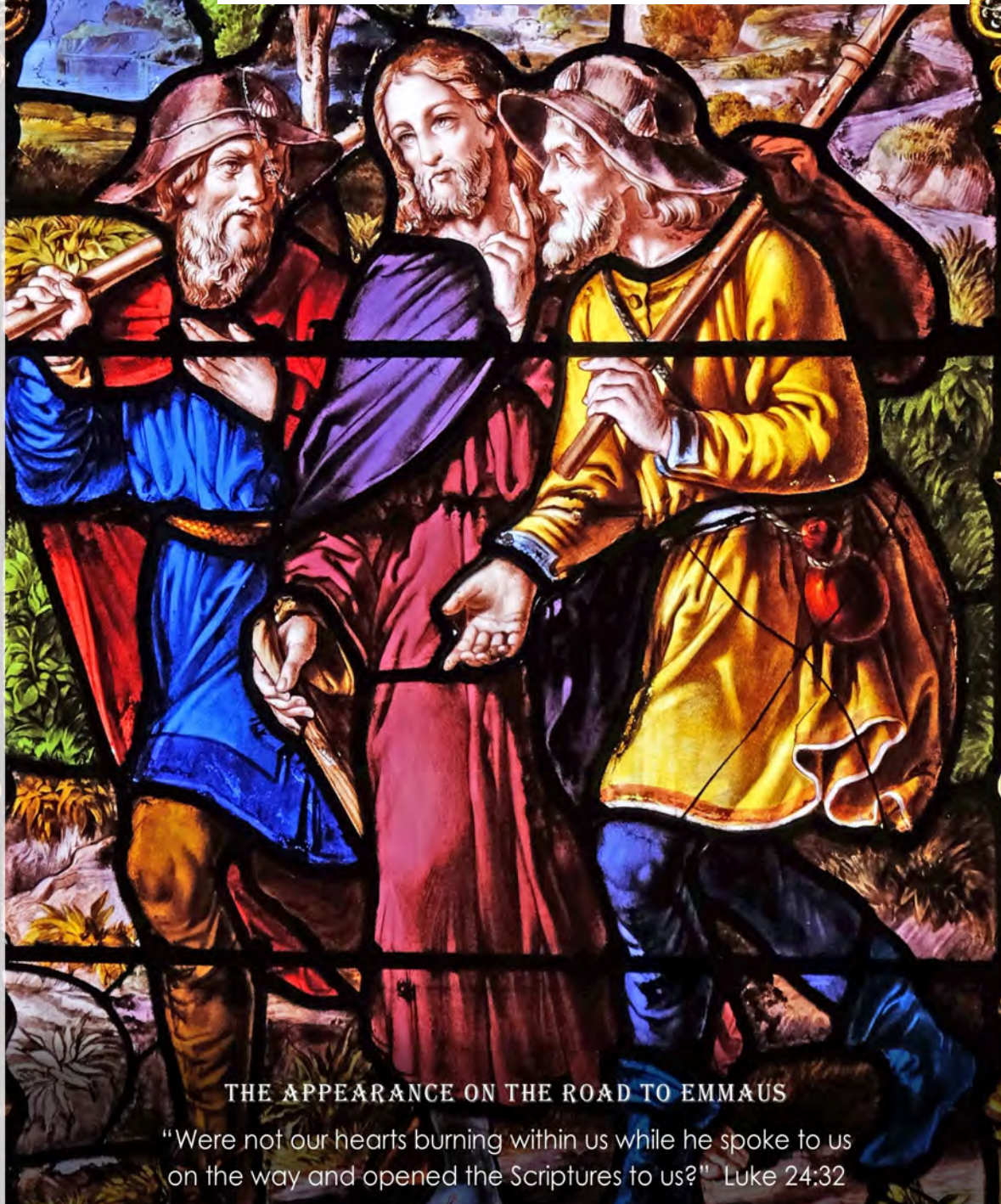

# TRUTH IN CHRIST!

*What a beautiful and grace-filled celebration!*

Close to 50 children received their First Holy Communion this past weekend at Our Lady of Hope and St. Paul's. It was truly a joyful and reverent occasion at both churches. Dressed in their very best, the children prayerfully proclaimed the Prayers of the Faithful and, for the first time, received the true presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

You could see how deeply they were moved—filled with both awe and excitement on such a sacred day. As they processed out of the church, the joyful voices of "This Little Light of Mine" echoed throughout the packed pews, a beautiful reminder of the light of Christ now shining within each of them.

It was a day full of grace, joy, and the presence of God among us.





## Why do Catholic churches use beeswax candles at Mass? (and why do they need to be at least 50% beeswax?)

At every Catholic Mass, candles are placed on or near the altar. But these aren't just decorative...**Even the material of the candle matters.**

For centuries, the Church has preferred **beeswax candles** for the sacred liturgy. Not simply for tradition — but because the candle itself proclaims something about **Jesus Christ**.

The entire candle is a symbol of Christ:

- The wax -> His body • The wick -> His human soul • The flame -> His divinity
- One candle...revealing the mystery of the Incarnation.

The Church Fathers saw even more: The beeswax specifically represents the **pure flesh Christ received from the Virgin Mary**. Something made in purity...set apart for something sacred.

**Even the bees point beyond themselves.** For centuries, Christians saw in them a symbol of **Our Lady's purity and self-gift** — producing something beautiful not for themselves, but for others.

And then there's the flame. A candle only gives light by **consuming itself**. It burns. It gives. It disappears...so others can see. That is the Cross.

This is where the "50% beeswax" comes in. The Church has long required candles to be made "**maxima parte**" (**for the most part**) of beeswax. Today, that usually means at least 50-51%.

Why does that matter? Because the symbol should be real, not artificial. The Mass is the **Holy Sacrifice**—so even the candles reflect **real sacrifice**.

There's even a hidden cost behind it: Bees labor to produce the wax and it's more expensive than synthetic alternatives, which means even this detail reflects offering **something costly and worthy to God**.

The most powerful example is the **Pascal Candle**. At the Easter Vigil, its flame spreads from person to person. It is a visible image of Christ's light passing from soul to soul.

**Every candle at Mass carries meaning.**

**It quietly reflects the mystery of Christ — His Incarnation, His sacrifice, and His light.**

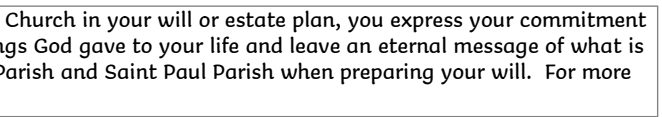


**Prayer for Our Country**

**IPSWICH KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS**

**IPSWICH KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS**



The Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization. It was founded by the Venerable Father Michael J. McGivney in New Haven, Connecticut, in 1882, and named in honor of the navigator Christopher Columbus. Originally serving as a mutual benefit society to low-income immigrant Catholics, it developed into a fraternal service organization dedicated to providing charitable services, promoting Catholic education, and actively defending Catholicism in various nations.

The Knights of Columbus is not just a fraternity in name. It is a brotherhood of Catholic men who each play a part in improving the world around them, one community at a time.
