

"LIVING GOD'S STORY" (G1-5)

Even with the impending snowstorm, we had a great turnout for Sunday classes this week participating in fun games, prayer, and hands-on learning.

GRADE 1: L12 - MARK 14:22-24: Learning about the Last Supper the students visited the church, where they learned more about the Tabernacle and the miracle of the Eucharist, deepening their understanding of Jesus' real presence among us.

GRADE 2: L1 - 1 CORINTHIANS 12:12-27: Beginning their preparation for First Communion, students learned what it means to be "part of the church".

GRADE 3: L10 - EPHESIANS 6:14-18: The students took time to reflect on Jesus' call to pray for others, creating and sharing prayers for those in need through a meaningful and joyful spiritual activity.

GRADE 4: L12 - 1 CORINTHIANS 12:14-18, 27: The Church is like a human body made up of many different parts. God created each person with a special role, and even though we are different, we need one another to work together as one body.

GRADE 5: L10 - 1 CORINTHIANS 12:1-11: St. Paul teaches that the Holy Spirit gives each person different gifts, and all of these gifts come from God and are meant to help others and build up the Church.


