FAITHFUL CATHOLICS CELEBRATE GOD & COUNTRY

Hundreds of us gathered together on June 28 & 29 at the Church of Saint Paul in Hamilton for a celebratory kickoff to the 250th Celebration of the United States of America. As pastor, we orchestrated a two-day affair for parishioners of Our Lady of Hope & Saint Paul, relying heavily on dedicated staff and parishioners for a Mass and two large scale events that brought together clergy, parishioners and citizens alike from Hamilton, Wenham, Ipswich and beyond. Bishop Hennessey, Auxiliary Bishop of Boston, presided over a Mass of Celebration which was followed by a colossal cookout, featuring a pig roast, music patriotic dessert competition, petting zoo and games and amusements for all ages, including an interactive proclamation of the Declaration of Independence.

Day 2 featured what has become the largest fraternal gathering of clergy in the Archdiocese of Boston. In attendance were seminarians, deacons, religious men and women who joined 123 Boston priests, along with Bishop Robert Hennessey, Bishop Arthur Kennedy and Bishop Naill Coll of Donegal, Ireland.

These events exemplify the desire and will of faithful Catholics of the Archdiocese of Boston and beyond to celebrate and honor God and Country. Once again I express my deepest gratitude to all who participated in these events.

I will remember what we pulled off with joy and gratefulness for the rest of my years.

2026-2027 CORI PROCESS HAS BEGUN

The CORI process has begun for 2026-2027. For those who have been volunteering at Our Lady of Hope OR St. Paul's the new CORI forms are available on the rectory porch, exit tables in church for you to take home and complete. Once completed, we need to verify your ID (driver's license or passport) in person. Not to overload Fr. Brogan at Mass, please stop by parish office and see Lucy Cronan to verify your picture ID (license).

Volunteers include anyone who help in service of their time and talent at Our Lady of Hope and Saint Paul. Volunteers are required to complete a CORI form EACH fiscal year. In addition, you must have completed the Protecting God's Children (PGC) Program and received the Archdiocesan Code of Conduct. If you are interested in volunteering, and have not volunteered during this past year; please call the rectory to receive a blue form for (NEW VOLUNTEERS) and read the notice to register for the Protecting God's Children in this bulletin to attend if you have not.

Thank you in advance for your help in this requirement and for all you do in helping us to be a vibrant parish.

PROTECTING GOD'S CHILDREN

All volunteers who minister in the Archdiocese must attend the Protecting God's Children and receive the Code of Conduct form. In addition, all current volunteers and new volunteers must complete a CORI Form. Those who need to follow this requirement are anyone who helps in building our church in any way. This list of volunteer includes: staff, teachers, assistants to religious education, lectors, eucharistic ministers, ushers, Finance and Pastoral Council members, etc. Please consider sharing your gifts and talents in our collaborative at Our Lady of Hope and St. Paul's by attending this training to be ready to serve.

- Add a Title (what you do for parish/school) in the box at bottom and click "Continue"
- On the next page, you may choose YES or NO depending on whether you want to associate your name with an additional school or parish
- Answer the four Yes/No questions on the next page and click "Continue"
- When asked "Have you already attended a VIRTUS Protecting God's Children Session?" answer NO.
- On the next page, choose date and church to attend Protecting God's Children for Adults"
- Confirm and you are done!

The Holiness of God in Daily Life

When God appeared to Moses on Mount Horeb, he said, "The place where you stand is holy ground" (Ex 3:5). The sixth chapter of Isaiah describes the prophet's vision of God and hearing the angels sing, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord" (Is 6:3). Moses reacts to God's holiness with awe, a deep reverence for the all-embracing majesty of God. Isaiah responds to God's holiness with an awareness of the profound and infinite purity of God. Both men undergo a spiritual transformation that they attribute to their experience of God's holiness.

The First Commandment

is more than a reference to an abstract idea of God. It is an announcement of the presence of the most holy God, both in outward creation and within the human soul. His existence does call for our faith.

Our surrounding culture is filled with many distractions that shut out the majestic voice of our holy and glorious God. St. Augustine, commenting on his troubled youth, speaks of this experience with these words, "You were with me, but

I was not with you. Created things kept me from you; yet if they had not been in you they would not have been at all." But God was not simply a passive presence to Augustine, a diffident lover wondering what to do. Augustine tells us that God spoke with a vigorous voice. "You called,

you shouted, and you broke through my deafness. You breathed your fragrance on me. . . I have tasted you, now I hunger and thirst for more

(*The Confessions*, bk. 10, no. 27).

This is the best context for appreciating the importance of the First Commandment. As God did with Augustine, he does for us again—calling, shouting, trying to break through our deafness, breathing his fragrance upon us. Many, indeed, are

listening. Numerous Catholics are seeking a deeper relationship with God through daily Mass, frequent reception of the Sacraments, the prayerful reading of Scripture, retreats, spiritual direction, diverse forms of prayer, and devotional practices. With Augustine, they can say, "You touched me, and I burned for your peace."

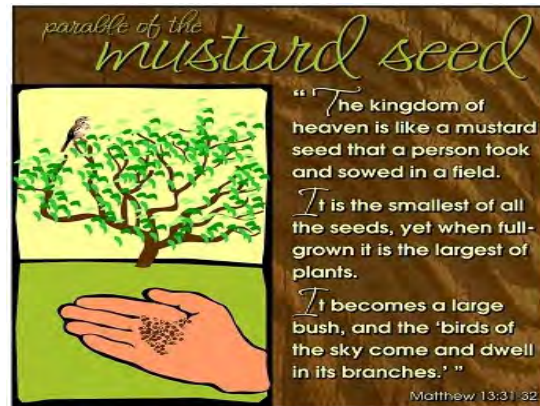

IPSWICH KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

IPSWICH KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS

The Knights of Columbus is the world's largest Catholic fraternal service organization. It was founded by the Venerable Father Michael J. McGivney in New Haven, Connecticut, in 1882, and named in honor of the navigator Christopher Columbus. Originally serving as a mutual benefit society to low-income immigrant Catholics, it developed into a fraternal service organization dedicated to providing charitable services, promoting Catholic education, and actively defending Catholicism in various nations.

The Knights of Columbus is not just a fraternity in name.

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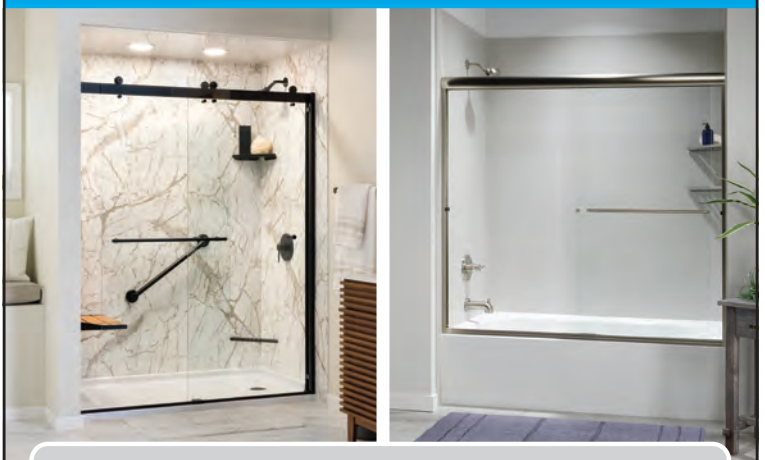
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
