

GRADE 1 RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

If you have a child who will be entering Grade 1 in September and want them to participate in Religious Education at Our Lady of Hope or Saint Paul's, please contact the parish office or Kristen Monahan, Director of Religious Education, kmonahan@ourladysaintpaul.org. Our Grade 2 First Penance/First Communion Program is a two-year program. We will need your child's baptism certificate at time of registration.

2025-2026 CORI PROCESS HAS BEGUN

The CORI process has begun for 2025-2026. For those who have been volunteering at Our Lady of Hope or Saint Paul, the new CORI forms are available on the rectory porch, exit tables in church and in the sacristy (OLH) for you to take home and complete. Once completed, we need to verify your ID (driver's license or passport) in person. Not to overload Fr. Brogan at Mass, please stop by the parish office and see Joanne DiNatale (OLH) or Lucy Cronan (STP) to verify your picture ID (license).

Volunteers include anyone who help in service of their time and talent at Our Lady of Hope. Volunteers are required to complete a CORI form EACH fiscal year. In addition, you must have completed the Protecting God's Children (PGC) Program and received the Archdiocesan Code of Conduct. If you are interested in volunteering, and have not volunteered during this past year; please call the rectory to receive a blue form for (NEW **VOLUNTEERS**) and read the notice to register for the Protecting God's Children in this bulletin to attend if you have not.

Thank you in advance for your help in this requirement and for all you do in helping us to be a vibrant parish.



Altar Servers are needed for both parishes. We are calling on all our RVERS young people 3rd grade and above to consider becoming altar servers

for their parish. When you volunteer to be an altar server you help the church in a wonderful way by assisting the presiding priest at God's Holy Altar. Not only is being an altar server good for your soul, it also helps you become a young leader; confident and comfortable standing up and serving in front of the whole congregation. Being an altar server teaches you to be responsible, follow a schedule, and commit to something important. We hope that many of you will be willing to serve as altar servers. It will be good for us, and good for you.

OCIA (Order of Christan Initiation of Adults)

Are you or someone you know interested in learning more about the Catholic faith? Perhaps you are thinking about what it means to be called to the Catholic way of life. The Church has a process called the Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (O.C.I.A.) whereby adults can learn and discern whether to become Catholic Christians. The process leads an unbaptized adult to his or her baptism, usually at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday. If the adult has been baptized in another Christian tradition, then the process prepares the person to be received into the Catholic Church by making a profession of faith as a Catholic. The process also prepares the way for someone who was baptized in the Catholic Church to receive First Holy Communion and Confirmation.

We are planning to start the OCIA process/ program in the Fall.


