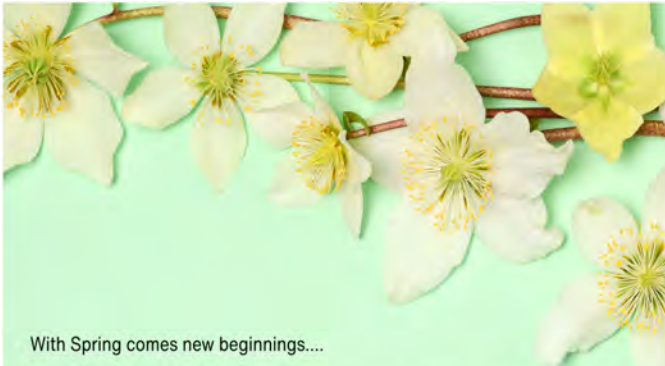

## Palm Sunday

### Holy Week Suggestions for Families

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of the most solemn week of the Church's liturgical year. During Holy Week, the Church celebrates the mysteries of salvation accomplished by Christ in the last days of his earthly life, beginning with the triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

For nearly 40 days, the Christian faithful have practiced the disciplines of Lent: prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Now the Church invites us to an even deeper spirit of prayer as we follow Christ on his journey to the Cross.

Here are some suggestions for families to use this week as an opportunity to grow in holiness as individuals and as a family.

1. During the week, pray the seven Penitential Psalms together (Psalm 6, 32, 38, 51, 102, 130, and 143; [www.usccb.org/bible/psalms/6](http://www.usccb.org/bible/psalms/6)). These are especially appropriate during Lent. Prayerfully reciting these psalms helps us to recognize our sinfulness, express our sorrow, and ask for God's forgiveness.
2. Celebrate the Sacrament of Penance if you haven't already done so during Lent.
3. Attend a service together on Holy Thursday and/or Good Friday. On Thursday, the Church recalls the Last Supper and Jesus' gift of his Body and Blood.
4. On Holy Saturday, pray for those who will be received into the Catholic Church during the Easter Vigil. Pray, too, for a deepening of your own faith and the grace to endure the suffering and celebrate the joys of married life.

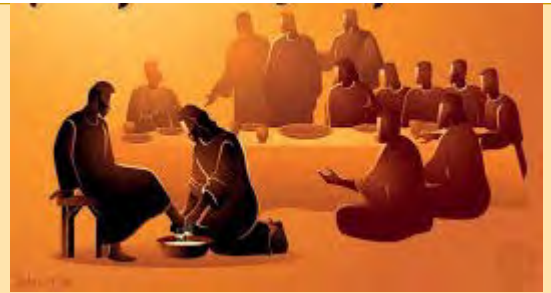

**"COME HOLY SPIRIT" (G6-8)** The students focused on the Bible passages: Luke 24:36-43, John 14:1-3, Acts 1:6-11, 2 Corinthians 5:10, 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17

These passages remind us of the hope and promise we have because of Jesus' Resurrection. It is a promise for us today. Jesus is alive, He prepares a place for us, He walks with us now, and one day He will bring us home to be with Him forever.

**"LIVING GOD'S STORY" (G1-5)** The children focused on upcoming Holy Week and the Easter Triduum:

The Last Supper: Jesus shows us how to care for others, live with humility, and stay connected to Him through the Eucharist.

Good Friday: we remember Jesus' crucifixion. Jesus died on the cross because of His great love for us and to save us from sin.

Easter Sunday: we celebrate the most joyful moment of our faith—Jesus rose from the dead. The Resurrection shows us that God's love is stronger than death and that Jesus brings new life and hope to the world.

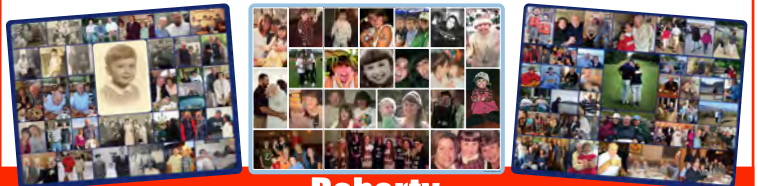

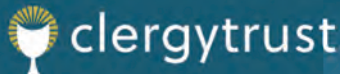

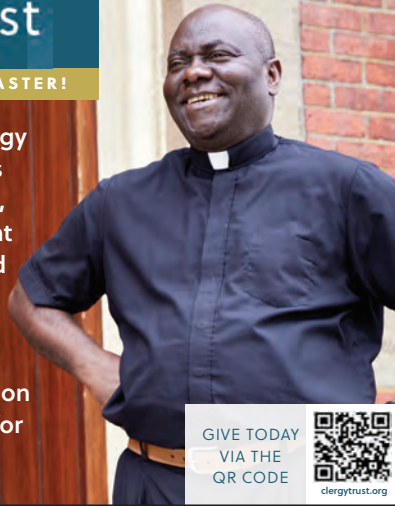
