elementary through high school groups! Here are our start dates, and full calendars and information can be found at www.ipswichcatholics.org:



St. Paul — EDGE Class Summary—Grades 6-8

Dear EDGE Families,

This week at Edge, we began a series called "Mapp My Life." Over the next few weeks, we will learn about the Eucharist and its transformative power in our lives. The title of each Edge Night is based on a road trip theme and asks questions related to the Eucharist, such as, "Why does the Eucharist matter?" and "Why isn't Mass more exciting?" This content seeks to give us a deeper understanding of the Eucharist and encourage us to receive this sacrament often.

This first Edge Night began with a game that involved solving riddles and finding hidden items throughout the church campus. Then we watched a short Matthew Kelly video about the Eucharist and what it means to be Catholic. This was followed by an opportunity to make trail mix to enjoy while discussing the teaching within their small groups. The Edge Night concluded with small groups creating a list of "God sightings" moments when we saw God working in our lives in the past week. We are all challenged to ask Jesus to help us be aware of His true presence when we are at Mass.

MAIN IDEAS

- The Eucharist, also known as Holy Communion and the Blessed Sacrament, is what we receive at Mass.
- Jesus is truly present in the Eucharist as a way to remain with us.
- God is present to us at every Catholic Mass because He loves us.

SCRIPTURE REFERENCE "Now as they were eating, Jesus took bread, and blessed, and broke it, and gave it to the disciples and said, 'Take, eat; this is my body.' And He took a cup, and when He had given thanks, He gave it to them, saying, 'Drink of it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins.'" (Matthew 26:26-28)

- How can you grow in awareness of Jesus' true presence in the Eucharist?
 How does Jesus remain in your life through His presence in the Eucharist?
