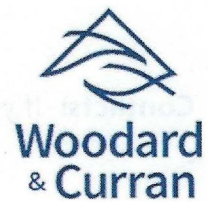




**LOWELL REGIONAL WASTEWATER UTILITY
DOWNTOWN AREA SEWER IMPROVEMENTS**



August 2026

WHAT: The City is rehabilitating and replacing portions of the sanitary sewer system in your area to improve system reliability, address structural deficiencies, and extend the life expectancy of the existing sewer infrastructure. The work will include a combination of pipeline rehabilitation via the installation of Cured-in-Place Pipe (CIPP) lining, open-cut sewer replacements, and rehabilitation of sewer manholes.

WHERE: Sewer improvements will be made in various locations within the City along the following streets: Hanover St, John Street Ave, Lee St, Howe St, East Merrimack St, Bartlett St, Church St, and Appleton St.

WHEN: Construction will start Monday August 10th, with typical work hours between the hours of 7 AM and 5 PM. Work is expected to be substantially complete by the end of October 2026 and final paving is expected to be completed by the middle of April 2027.

WHY: The Project will address deteriorated sewer infrastructure, reducing the risk of potential backups, while also improving the long-term reliability of the sewer system in these areas.

WHO: Lowell Regional Wastewater Utility (City), GVC Construction (Contractor), and Woodard & Curran (Engineer) will be overseeing this work.

Impact on Area: Construction crews will be working within the roadways identified above and access may be temporarily affected. Expect minor traffic delays, but police details and traffic signage shall assist you as navigate the work area. Street parking may also be impacted temporarily, but will be clearly marked in advance, so please plan accordingly. Typical construction noises should also be expected throughout the duration of the Project. All impacts will be minimized to the maximum extent practicable, and access will be maintained whenever possible.
