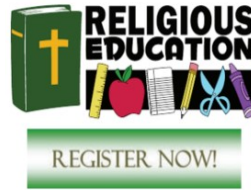


Sunday and Holyday Mass Obligation Restored.

This past week, Archbishop Wester restored the obligation to attend Mass on all Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation in the Archdiocese of Santa Fe. You can read the Archbishop's letter (in Spanish as well as English) at <https://www.iccabq.org>. As always, Catholics are never obligated to attend Mass if ill or infirmed to the point that Mass attendance is not possible.

As the Archbishop writes in his letter: "As the Code of Canon Law reminds us, "Sunday is the day on which the Pascal Mystery is celebrated in light of the apostolic tradition and is to be observed as the foremost holy day of obligation in the universal Church." (CIC, can. 1246, §1) The Letter to the Hebrews urges the faithful "not to neglect to meet together, as is the habit of some, but to encourage one another." (Heb. 10:25).

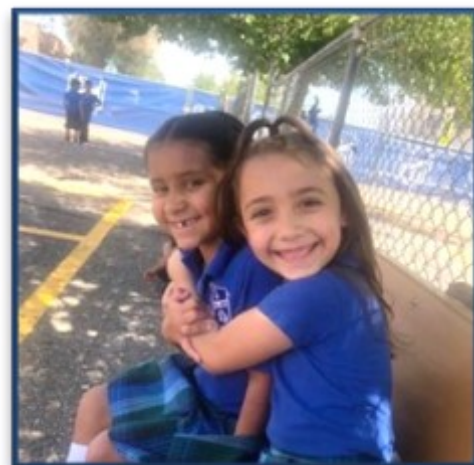

22nd Sunday in Ordinary Time, Cycle C
Sunday, August 28, 2022

Luke 14:1,7-14 ~ When you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, and the blind.

Meals played an important role in the society in which Jesus lived. More than a time for sharing nourishment, they were a time to share ideas and to model different aspects of social relationships. In Luke's Gospel, the places that a person ate (at the home of a tax collector, 5:29), the people with whom a person ate (sinners, 5:30), whether a person washed before eating (11:38), and, as is the case here, the place that a person sits while eating are all important. The narrator says Jesus tells a parable, but it is really wise advice to both guests and hosts about finding true happiness at the heavenly banquet.

TODOS LOS MINISTERIOS DE LA PARROQUIA Y VOLUNTARIOS

Un componente esencial del ministerio parroquial es asegurar la seguridad de nuestros Parroquianos, particularmente de los mas vulnerables – niños, ancianos y enfermos. La archidiócesis de Santa Fe requiere el curso de "Entrenamiento para reconocer el abuso de cualquier clase para adultos", empleados de parroquias dentro de la Archidiócesis así como para voluntarios como ustedes. El entrenamiento nos ayuda a estar vigilantes y a reconocer comportamientos inapropiados, para evitarlos en nosotros mismos y reconocerlos cuando los observamos en otros que puedan constituir una amenaza.

Esta regla requiere que empleados y ministros voluntarios de la Archidiócesis de Santa Fe necesitan tomar esta clase cada cinco años. Este requisito incluye una investigación de antecedentes criminales. *Se les notificará si han pasado más de cinco años desde su último entrenamiento documentado.*

El entrenamiento tiene dos opciones: en persona y en línea. No requiere gastos de ninguna clase. Por favor asegúrese de que la Oficina de la Parroquia tiene archivado su certificado.
