### What Items are Needed?

**Back to School Supplies (new):** big backpacks, colored pencils, earbuds, headphones, lunch bags, lunch boxes, markers (regular - wide), markers (permanent), mechanical pencils, pencil boxes/bags, pencil sharpeners, post-its, tape, water bottles

**Calculators (new or gently used):** Texas Instrument 34 & 83 models

**Personal Items (new):** Brushes, Conditioner (travel size), Deodorant, Ponytail holders, Razors, Shampoo (travel size), Shaving cream, Soap (travel size), Underwear

**Books (new or gently used):** All school ages
