Freedom 2 Hope Prison Ministry

When residents come from prison, they are usually in a tough situation – meaning no job or steady income, no transportation to the many places they are required to go, limited healthy support and relationships, and many other personalized issues across the board. One of the many ways ONE80 has volunteered to help is in the area of transportation. We have comprised a team of volunteers under Freedom 2 Hope who make themselves available to the ladies who are in need of transportation. We assist them in getting to so many places! ONE80 has always helped provide transportation, but since the end of May, we have given 67 rides to our residents.

We also have a goal to empower these beautiful women to be responsible for their own transportation when possible. We held a transportation class and assisted the ladies in exploring their options as they took their "first steps". Examples of this include learning how to take the public bus system as well as utilizing a bicycle to get to and from work instead of relying on others when feasible. These women have stepped up and shown their determination to succeed, and we are so very proud of each of them.

We still need your help! When we are unable to find a volunteer driver, the ministry pays for Uber services – making sure the resident does not miss important appointments.
