

Going into the Cumberland County prison is an honor. I once walked through those same corridors in prison attire, many, many times. I've known the staff and Correctional officers sometimes on a first name basis. But, because I was the inmate. And because I was an inmate there for many years, I know the importance of having committed and dedicated ladies come in and minister to the lost, which is what I was once. Thankfully Jesus showed up!! And I began to follow Him.

One evening while entering the prison, my daughter, Sara, retrieved the Inmate sign in sheet at Central. When she came into the Chapel, she told me I needed to go see who was working Central. So, I approached, and there sat a CO, who I will call Ms. M, who I've known through good times and bad times. I was not always the model inmate! But seeing her after all this time (it's been approx. 10 yrs since I was last incarcerated there) made me cry like a baby. She saw a new and improved Sue. Not the old Sue. And thank you Jesus for allowing me to experience this.

So, once the Bible study got started, and after we spent time in worship, which is so special for the ladies, the door to the Chapel opened. In walked Ms. M. She apologized for interrupting but pointed to my daughter, Sara, and I, and said that we were so special. And that seeing us coming in and doing the Lord's work was so rewarding to her. She said she was so proud of us! Not only was it rewarding to her but to Sara and I as well. Sara knew Ms. M as well when she was incarcerated there too. See, Sara and I both were incarcerated there together at the same time. Along with my other daughter, Shelley (who is no longer with us) All 3 of us were here together. UGH! But Jesus brought us back to spread His love and that's just what we are going to do!

We need to show the ladies that there is a better way. What a difference life can be when inviting Jesus to lead the way.

Each time I walk through those gates to enter the prison is so surreal. Getting to walk out after a Bible study, knowing we're trying to make a difference, is more surreal.

God is so good.

Seeing the look on Ms. M's face and knowing I have changed and knowing I'm trying to help these ladies make that same change, is very important to me. It's important to my daughter, Sara, too. She knows the importance of going into the prison as well. The Lord has brought us both so far.

Thank you One80 for giving us the opportunity to do this amazing work with you.

I also want to thank Jesus for giving us this opportunity as well.



Ministry Reminders
