## FREEDOM 2 HOPE PRISON MINISTRY

Freedom 2 Hope has been going into Cumberland County Prison to hold Bible Studies for over a year. It has been such a blessing to hear how much this means to some of those who are incarcerated. We also have been praying about the possibility of going into other local prisons, but it seemed that God didn't open those doors for us...until now!

This is how God so worked that we are now invited to go into Dauphin County Prison!

Julia, One80's Executive Director was invited to speak at an event for the Christian Churches United of the Tri-County Area and it was hosted by the Mechanicsburg Presbyterian Church. Inmates on work release were there from Dauphin County, and a group of us "just so happened" to sit across from them at the table.

As Julia shared her testimony and what One80 Ministries is about, the inmates were very impressed to the point they wanted us to pick them up on Sunday to go to church! They asked us if we could possibly call DCP to speak with the officer in charge so that permission would be granted for us to pick them up.

I was given the job to make the call and when I did call, the officer said that they already give the inmates the opportunity to go to church on Sunday. I then thought about asking this officer if it would be possible for our group to go into DCP for Bible Studies. They said "it just so happens" that a new Chaplain was just appointed so they would transfer my call to him. I immediately started to pray that I would be able to speak to the Chaplain. After being on hold for a while, I almost hung up because I thought that he probably was too busy to take my call....but I patiently waited and I was amazed that he did pick up the phone!

After a wonderful conversation with Chaplain Gsell, he said that they are in need of people who would come in to hold life skills meetings. I was excited that this was God working for us to go into DCP. As our conversation continued on, I felt led to invite him to come to One80 so that we could show him around the building and to be able to share more with him about our ministry. Chaplain Gsell said yes!!

At our meeting, Chaplain Gsell gave us the needed information of what it would look like going into Dauphin County. We are in the process of planning how to effectively organize meetings at both CCP and DCP.

So now this is an invitation to YOU if you feel that God is tugging at your heart strings to join a group going into the local prisons. We need more volunteers to join us. We feel God is leading us to go....but we are few in numbers and we need committed Christian volunteers who have the desire to share the love of Jesus to those who are incarcerated.

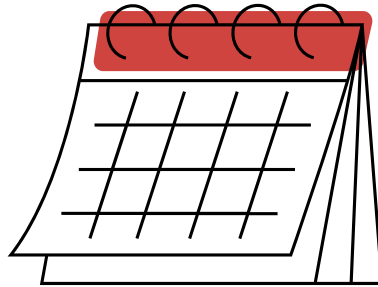
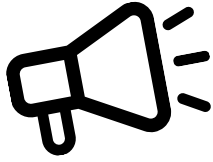
