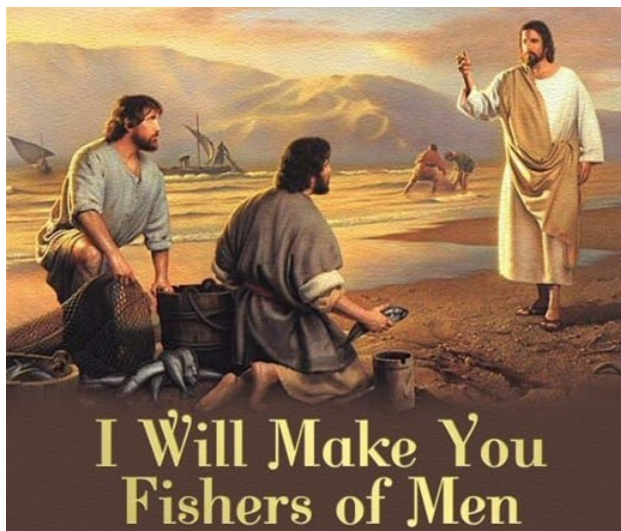
MARRIAGE
