

Conversation Bingo

This Conversation Bingo activity will help classmates connect and get to know each other.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Give each participant a 'Conversation Bingo' card and pen/pencil.
- In an open space, encourage participants to mingle, and use the bingo cards to have conversations with others.
- Participants write the name of the person they connected with in the corresponding box.
- The first person to fill in four boxes across, down, or diagonally yells "Conversation Bingo!"
If time allows you can extend this to two rows, or the whole grid.
- We have provided you with two worksheets to get the conversations started plus a blank template for you to come up with your own conversation starters.
- Ask participants to share how they feel after getting to know one another.
- Emphasise that when we get to know each other we build trust and have meaningful conversations that help others open up about life's ups and downs, big and small.
- Remind everyone that it's important to keep the conversations going and ask, 'are you OK?' Any Day.

Tip: Have some extra time? At the end of each round, encourage participants to continue the conversations they started during the game, so they can get to know each other better.
