Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Supervisors of Kemper County, Mississippi at the Kemper County Courthouse located at 280 Veterans Street in DeKalb, MS, until **10:00 am Friday, August 14, 2026**. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted.

The work is generally described as:

**NEW GAS REGULATOR STATION PIPING – ARC PROJECT NO. MS21499**

The principal items of work involve providing the labor, equipment, and materials necessary for the construction of 1,350 linear feet of 6” HDPE gas line, various size steel gas piping, valves, reducers, tees, elbows, and other appurtenances and incidental work as required for a new natural gas regulator station at the Kemper County regulator station site near Mark Cobb Road in Kemper County, MS

Bid security in the form of a bid bond equal to 5% of the total bid is required. Contract security in the form of 100% Performance and Payment Bonds will be required. No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of thirty (30) days. Bidding and Contract Documents may be purchased from the Engineer upon prior payment of a fee of \$100.00, which is non-refundable. Each bidder shall provide a Mississippi Certificate of Responsibility or their bid will not be opened or considered.
