Sealed bids will be received by the Board of Supervisors of Lauderdale County, Mississippi at the office of Engineering Plus, Inc. located at 1724-B 23rd Avenue, Meridian, MS, until **9:00 am Monday, September 21, 2026** for Lauderdale County Bid Number 4039. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after the stated time will not be accepted.

The work is generally described as:

CENTERHILL-MARTIN ROAD BRIDGE REPAIR

The principal items of work involve coffer dam installation, steel pile encasements, riprap installation and FRP wrap on bridge caps for Bridges SA38-254 & SA38-255 over Okatibbee Reservoir in Lauderdale County, MS.

Bid security in the form of a bid bond equal to 5% of the total bid is required. Contract security in the form of 100% Performance and Payment Bonds will be required. No bid may be withdrawn after closing time for the receipt of proposals for a period of thirty (30) days. Each bidder shall provide a Mississippi Certificate of Responsibility or their bid will not be opened or considered.
