Sealed bids for **Kemper Recreation Park Improvements** will be received by the Board of Supervisors (Board) of Kemper County, Mississippi at the Kemper County Courthouse located at 280 Veterans Street in DeKalb, Mississippi until **9:00 a.m., Friday, June 19, 2026** and shortly thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.

Scope of work consists primarily of two new 200' ballfields including fields, fencing, lighting and minimal site grading. Project alternate includes construction of post tension pickleball courts.

The work to be done is generally as shown in the plans and technical specifications.
