# Pope Leo XIV Appoints Rev. Andres "Andy" Ligot as Auxiliary Bishop of the Diocese of San José



SAN JOSÉ, Calif. — The Diocese of San José joyfully announces that Pope Leo XIV has appointed Rev. Andres "Andy" C. Ligot as Auxiliary Bishop of San José. Earlier today, Bishop Oscar Cantú introduced Bishop-elect Ligot at a press conference held in the Chancery offices.

"Today we rejoice with gratitude for Bishop-elect Ligot's 'yes' to the Lord and to the Church in Silicon Valley," said Bishop Oscar Cantú. "His priestly heart, pastoral experience, and steady leadership will bless our parishes, schools, and ministries. I invite the faithful to keep him in prayer as he prepares for episcopal ordination."

"I am humbled by the Holy Father's trust and by Bishop Cantú's support," said Bishop-elect Ligot. "I renew my promise to serve Christ and His people with joy—especially those most in need. Please pray for me, that I may be a faithful servant and a good shepherd in our beautifully diverse Church."

**Ordination:** Details regarding the date, time, and place of episcopal ordination will be announced soon. Bishop-elect Ligot will become the second auxiliary bishop appointed to the Diocese of San José and the sixth US prelate who is a native of the Philippines.
