## TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

On July 31, 2025, the Court entered an Order which granted Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement, granted conditional class certification, approved the format of the Class Notice, and set a Final Approval Hearing (the "Preliminary Approval Order"), thereby preliminarily approving a settlement of the above-entitled action (the "Action") that was reached between plaintiff Mariano Aguirre Jr. ("Plaintiff") and defendant Barry-Wehmiller Companies, Inc. ("Defendant") (together with Plaintiff, the "Parties"), in accordance with the Parties' Class Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement and Class Notice (the "Settlement"). The Amended Settlement was attached as **Exhibit 1** to the Supplemental Declaration of Kane Moon in Support of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement that was filed on April 1, 2025.

The Court has entered an Order granting final approval of the Parties' Settlement (the "Final Approval Order"). The Court now has before it a [Proposed] Judgment.

The Court, having entered a Final Approval Order in this Action, and good cause appearing, HEREBY ADJUDGES AND DECREES AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Court, for purposes of this Judgment, refers to and incorporates all terms and definitions as set forth in the Settlement.
- 2. The Court enters Judgment as follows: Plaintiff, Class Members, Class Counsel, PAGA Members, the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, the State of California, and the Administrator shall take nothing except as expressly set forth in the Final Approval Order and according to the terms of the Settlement.
- 3. The Parties shall bear their own respective attorneys' fees and costs, except as otherwise provided for in the Settlement and approved by the Court.
- 4. This Judgment and the concurrently filed Final Approval Order are intended to be a final disposition of the Action in its entirety and are intended to be immediately appealable.
- 5. Notwithstanding the finality of this Judgment, pursuant to California Rules of Court Rule 3.769, *et seq.* and California Code of Civil Procedure section 664.6, the Court shall retain

1	jurisdiction over the Parties, Action, and the Settlement solely for purposes of (i) enforcing the	
2	Settlement and/or Judgment, (ii) addressing settlement administration matters, and (iii) addressing	
3	such post-Judgment matters as are permitted by law.
