1 This matter has come before the Honorable Beth Labson Freeman, whose
2 courtroom is located in Courtroom 1 of the United States District Court for the
3 Northern District of California, San Jose Courthouse, 280 South First Street, 5th
4 Floor, San Jose, California 95113, on Plaintiff Nelson Ramirez’s (“Plaintiff”)
5 Motion for Attorneys’ Fees and Costs and Enhancement Payment.

6 On November 20, 2024, the Court entered an Order Granting Preliminary
7 Approval of Class Action and PAGA Settlement (Docket No. 169) (“Preliminary
8 Approval Order”), and thereby preliminarily approved the settlement of the above-
9 entitled action (“Action”) in accordance with the Joint Stipulation of Class Action
10 and PAGA Settlement and Release (“Agreement” or “Settlement Agreement”)
11 entered into by and between Plaintiff and Defendant HV Global Management
12 Corporation (“Defendant”), which, together with the exhibits annexed thereto set
13 forth the terms and conditions for settlement of the Action (“Settlement”).

14 Having reviewed the Settlement Agreement and duly considered the parties’
15 papers and oral argument, and good cause appearing,

16 **THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS, ADJUDGES, AND DECREES AS**
17 **FOLLOWS:**

18 1. All terms used herein shall have the same meaning as defined in the
19 Settlement Agreement and the Preliminary Approval Order.

20 2. This Court has jurisdiction over the claims of the Class Members
21 asserted in this proceeding and over all parties to the Action.

22 3. The Court hereby grants Plaintiff’s Motion for Attorneys’ Fees and
23 Costs and Enhancement Payment.

24 4. The Court finds that the Enhancement Payment sought is fair and
25 reasonable for the work performed by Plaintiff on behalf of the Class Members. It
26 is hereby ordered that the Settlement Administrator issue payment in the amount of
27 **\$10,000.00** to Plaintiff Nelson Ramirez for his Enhancement Payment, in
28 accordance with the terms and methodology set forth in the Settlement Agreement.
