[PROPOSED] PRELIMINARY APPROVAL ORDER

The Motion for Preliminary Approval of a Class Action Settlement came before this Court.

The Court having considered the papers submitted in support of the motion of the Parties,

HEREBY ORDERS THE FOLLOWING:

- 1. The Court grants Preliminary Approval of the Settlement and the Settlement Class based upon the terms set forth in the Class Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement and Class Notice ("Settlement Agreement" or "Settlement") filed herewith. The Settlement appears to be fair, adequate, and reasonable to the Class.
- 2. The Settlement falls within the range of reasonableness and appears to be presumptively valid, subject only to any objections that may be raised at the final fairness hearing

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and final approval by this Court.

- 3. A final fairness hearing on the question of whether the proposed Settlement, attorney's fees to Class Counsel, and the Class Representative's enhancement fee should be finally approved as fair, reasonable and adequate as to the members of the Class is scheduled for May 2, 2024, at \_\_\_\_\_ \bar{E} \bar{E} \bar{a} \bar{m}. (Pacific Time), in Department SSC-10.
- 4. The Court approves, as to form and content, the Notice of Class Action Settlement and Hearing Date for Final Court Approval (Exhibit 1, hereinafter "Notice Packet") in substantially the form attached to the Settlement Agreement. The objection/opt-out deadline shall be sixty (60) days from the date of the mailing of the Notice Packet in order to provide Class Members and PAGA Group Members ample time to review and consider their options under the proposed settlement. The Court approves the procedure for Class Members to object to the Class Settlement as set forth in the Notice Packet.
- 5. The Court directs the mailing of the Notice Packet by first class mail to the Class Members in accordance with the Implementation Schedule set forth below. The Court finds that the dates selected for the mailing and distribution of the Notice Packet, as set forth in the Implementation Schedule, meet the requirements of due process and provide the best notice practicable under the circumstances and shall constitute due and sufficient notice to all persons entitled thereto.
- 6. It is ordered that the Settlement Class is preliminarily certified for settlement purposes only.
- 7. The Court appoints Darren M. Cohen of Kingsley & Kingsley, APC as Class Counsel.
  - 8. The Court appoints Romulo Gomez as the Class Representative.
  - 9. The Court appoints ILYM Group, Inc. as the Settlement Administrator.
  - 10. The Court orders the following Implementation Schedule for further proceedings:
