Settlement Allocation and Settlement Execution of << MERGED_Name>>.

The settlement allocation formula is as follows:

Each Class Member is entitled to a proportionate share of the Claim Settlement Sum ("CSS") of \$210,000. The Parties have agreed that ninety percent (90%) of each Class Member's payment shall be treated as non-wage damages and shall be reported on an IRS Form 1099, and that ten percent (10%) of each Class Member's Payment shall be treated as wages and shall be reported on an IRS Form W-2. Attorneys' fees are separately accounted for and will not be deducted from the CSS. In recognition of their assistance, the Plaintiffs who filed the lawsuit will receive service awards totaling \$5,000.00 from the CSS.

Aside from the service awards, all Class Members' minimum individual allocations are otherwise calculated on a *pro rata* basis based upon each of their "best day" damages during the relevant time period. The maximum relevant time period began on July 1, 2021 and concludes on June 30, 2022.
