

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28 ORDER

1 This matter came before the Honorable Joseph M. Quinn of the Superior Court of the State
2 of California, in and for the County San Francisco, on March 18, 2026, for the motion by Plaintiffs
3 Irwandie Tio, Xavier Brown, Felix Gunawan, Taje Fleming, Toma Stavrev, and Saif Ahmed
4 (collectively, "Plaintiffs") for preliminary approval of the class settlement with Defendant
5 Transdev Alternative Services, Inc. ("Defendant").

6 Plaintiffs' Motion For Preliminary Approval Of Class Action And PAGA Settlement is
7 GRANTED IN SUBSTANTIAL PART.

8 The court: (1) preliminarily approves the proposed settlement of this class action with
9 Defendant Transdev Alternative Services, Inc. ("Defendant"); (2) preliminarily approves the
10 settlement as fair, adequate and reasonable; (3) preliminarily approves the gross settlement amount
11 of \$2,000,000.00; (4) for settlement purposes only, conditionally certifies the Class as "all
12 individuals who are or were previously employed by Defendant in California and classified as a
13 non-exempt employee and worked at least a day at any time during the Class Period." The Class
14 Period is November 21, 2019 to January 24, 2025; (5) provisionally appoints Plaintiffs as the
15 representatives of the Class; (6) [intentionally left blank]; (7) provisionally appoints Norman B.
16 Blumenthal, Kyle R. Nordrehaug, Aparajit Bhowmik, Nicholas J. De Blouw, Jeffrey S. Herman,
17 Sergio J. Puche, and Trevor G. Moran of Blumenthal Nordrehaug Bhowmik De Blouw LLP and
18 Edwin Aiwazian, Joanna Ghosh, and Melissa A. LeBlanc-Mansell of Lawyers for Justice, P.C., as
19 Class Counsel; (8) provisionally approves an attorneys' fees award not to exceed \$666,600 (one-
20 third of the Gross Settlement Amount), an award of litigation expenses incurred, not to exceed
21 \$100,000; (9) preliminarily approves Class Representative Service Payments to the Plaintiffs in an
22 amount not to exceed \$15,000 each (10) approves the form and method of notice, including notice
23 being provided electronically where feasible; (11) approves the proposed opt-out procedure; (12)
24 directs that notice of the proposed settlement be given to the class; (13) appoints ILYM Group,
25 Inc. as Administrator for the Settlement; no later than fifteen (15) calendar days after issuance of
26 this Order, Defendant shall provide an electronic spreadsheet with the Class Data to the
27 Administrator, which includes the personal email address for the Class Members if know and

1 available to the Defendant; this information will otherwise remain confidential and will not be
2 disclosed to anyone, except as required to applicable taxing authorities, to carry out the procedures
3 in the Agreement, or pursuant to Defendant's express written authorization or by order of the
4 Court; the Administrator will perform address updates and verifications as necessary prior to the
5 mailing of the Class Notice; and, using best efforts to mail it as soon as possible, and in no event
6 later than fourteen (14) calendar days after receiving the Class Data spreadsheet, the Administrator
7 will mail the Class Notice Packet to all Class; and, (14) sets a final approval hearing date for
8 November 2, 2026, at 9:00 am in this department, for which Plaintiff shall file and serve a timely
9 (under the Code of Civil Procedure) noticed motion for final approval of settlement, with courtesy
10 copy delivered to the department within 24 hours of filing; any opposition to such motion may be
11 in writing filed with the court at least nine court days before the hearing or provided orally at the
12 hearing.


13 To the extent Plaintiffs seek different or additional relief, the motion is denied.
