PLAINTIFF SANTOS QUINTAL's Motion For Preliminary Approval Of Class Action And Paga Settlement Plaintiff Santos Quintal's unopposed Motion For Preliminary Approval Of Class Action And PAGA Settlement is GRANTED IN PART AND DENIED IN PART. Good cause appearing, the court: (1) preliminarily approves the proposed settlement of this class action with Defendants Sasala Dining USA Inc. and Masao Kuribara ("Defendants"); (2) for settlement purposes only, conditionally certifies the Class, which is comprised of "all non-exempt employees who were worked for Sasala Dining USA Inc. as a non-exempt employee during the Class Period"; (3) provisionally appoints Plaintiff as the representatives of the Class; (4) provisionally appoints Matthew A. To the extent Plaintiff seeks different or additional relief, the motion is denied. Much of the relief requested but not granted is not necessary or appropriate for preliminary approval.
