The Court, having read the papers filed regarding Plaintiff's unopposed Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement, and having heard argument regarding the Motion on September 11, 2025, hereby finds and ORDERS as follows:

1           1.     The Class Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement and Class Notice  
2 ("Settlement Agreement") attached to the Kazandjian Declaration as **Exhibit 1**, is within the  
3 range of possible recovery and, subject to further consideration at the Final Approval Hearing  
4 described below, is preliminarily approved as fair, reasonable, and in the best interest of the  
5 absent class members;

6           2     For purposes of settlement only, the Court provisionally and conditionally  
7 certifies the following class: All persons who are or were employed by Defendants Simonmed  
8 Imaging; Simonmed Imaging MSO, LLC; SMI IMAGING, LLC, and Health Diagnostics Of  
9 California, a Professional Corporation in California and classified as hourly, non-exempt  
10 employees during the Class Period of June 27, 2020, to the date the Court grants Plaintiffs'  
11 motion for preliminary approval of the Settlement.

12           3.     The Court finds the Settlement Class, consisting of approximately 445 members,  
13 is so numerous that joinder of all members is impracticable, and that the Settlement Class is  
14 ascertainable by reference to the business records of Defendants.

15           4.     The Court finds further there are questions of law and fact common to the entire  
16 Settlement Class, which common questions predominate over any individualized questions of  
17 law or fact. These common questions include, without limitation: (1) whether Defendants paid  
18 Settlement Class Members for all hours worked, (2) whether Defendant provided Settlement  
19 Class Members with all required meal and rest periods, or compensation in lieu thereof, (3)  
20 whether Defendants properly reimbursed Settlement Class Members for business expenses, and  
21 (4) whether Defendants provided Settlement Class Members with proper itemized wage  
22 statements.

23           5.     The Court finds further the claims of named Plaintiffs Nora Ridge and Leticia  
24 Velazquez are typical of the claims of the Settlement Class, and that they will fairly and  
25 adequately protect the interests of the Settlement Class. Accordingly, the Court appoints  
26 Plaintiffs Nora Ridge and Leticia Velazquez as the Class Representatives, and appoints their  
27 counsel of record Haig B. Kazandjian Lawyers, APC, as Class Counsel.

28           6.     The Court finds further that certification of the Settlement Class is superior to

other available means for the fair and efficient adjudication of the controversy.

7. The Court finds further that, in the present case, the proposed method of providing notice of the Settlement to the Settlement Class via First Class U.S. Mail to each Settlement Class Member's last known address, is reasonably calculated to notify the Settlement Class Members of the proposed Settlement and provides the best notice possible under the circumstances. The Court also finds the Notice of Class Action Settlement form is sufficient to inform the Settlement Class Members of the terms of the Settlement and their rights thereunder, including the right to object to the Settlement or any part thereof and the procedure for doing so, their right to exclude themselves from the Settlement and the procedure for doing so, their right to obtain a portion of the Settlement proceeds, and the date, time and location of the Final Approval Hearing. The proposed Notice of Class Action Settlement (Exhibit A to the Settlement Agreement) and the procedure for providing Notice set forth in the Settlement Agreement, are approved by the Court.

8. Under the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the Court approves the Parties' selection of ILYM Group, Inc. as the Settlement Administrator. The Settlement Administrator is ordered to mail the Class Notice to the Settlement Class Members via First-Class U.S. Mail as specified in the Settlement Agreement, and to otherwise carry out all other duties set forth in the Settlement Agreement. The Parties are ordered to carry out and comply with all terms of this Order and the Settlement Agreement, and particularly with respect to providing the Settlement Administrator all information necessary to perform its duties under the Settlement Agreement.

9. Any member of the Settlement Class who wishes to be excluded, or object to the Settlement or any term thereof, including any proposed award of attorney's fees and costs to Class Counsel or any proposed representative enhancement to the Class Representatives, shall have forty-five (45) days from the mailing of the Class Notice to request exclusion and/or to object, as set forth in the Settlement Agreement and Class Notice.

10. A Final Approval Hearing is hereby set for February 11, 2026, at 8:30a.m; OR for \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_, 2026, at \_\_:\_\_ a.m./p.m. in Department M of the Los Angeles County Superior Court, Santa Monica Courthouse, to consider any objections to the Settlement,

determine if the proposed Settlement should be found fair, adequate and reasonable and given full and final approval by the Court, and to determine the amount of attorney's fees and costs awarded to Class Counsel, the amount of any representative enhancement award to the Class Representative, and to approve the fees and costs payable to the Settlement Administrator. All legal memoranda, affidavits, declarations, or other evidence in support of the request for final approval, the award of attorney's fees and costs to Class Counsel, the enhancement award to the Class Representative, and the fees and costs of the Settlement Administrator, shall be filed no later than sixteen (16) court days prior to the Final Approval Hearing. The Court reserves the right to continue the Final Approval Hearing without further notice to the Settlement Class Members.


11. Provided he or she has not submitted a timely and valid Request for Exclusion, any Settlement Class Member may appear, personally or through his or her own counsel, and be heard at the Final Approval Hearing regardless of whether he or she has submitted a written objection.

b.	Deadline for Settlement Administrator to Mail the Notice Packets to Class Members	October 2, 2025  OR _____, 2025 [within 14 days of receipt of the Class List and Data Report from Defendants]
c.	Deadline for Settlement Class Members to postmark Requests for Exclusions	November 17, 2025  OR _____, 2025 [45 days after mailing of the Notice Packet to Class Members]

d.	Deadline for the postmark of any Objections to the Settlement	November 17, 2025  OR _____, 2025 [45 days after mailing of the Notice Packet to Class Members]
e.	Deadline for Class Counsel to File Motion for Final Approval of Settlement Including the requested attorneys' fees and costs including any expenses and declarations in support thereof; and deadline to file declaration by ILYM Group Inc. Re Service of Class Notice, receipt and filing of objections	January 20, 2026  OR _____, 2025 [16 court days prior to hearing on Motion for Final Approval]
