1 Plaintiff Jessica Lopez (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant Lecangs LLC (“Defendant”) (Plaintiff and
2 Defendant are herein collectively referred to as the “Parties”), by and through their respective
3 counsel of record, hereby enter into the stipulation below with reference to the following facts:

4 **WHEREAS**, the Parties have executed a long form settlement agreement resolving the
5 above-referenced wage and hour and PAGA action; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Court granted preliminary approval of the class action settlement on
7 February 4, 2026, and scheduled a final approval hearing for June 24, 2026; and

8 **WHEREAS**, there are approximately 913 class members in this case, with the class
9 primarily comprised of staffing agency employees;

10 **WHEREAS**, per the terms of the approved settlement agreement between the Parties, the
11 class data was due by February 18, 2026;

12 **WHEREAS**, as of May 1, 2026, Defendant obtained from the staffing agencies and
13 provided to the settlement administrator the mailing addresses and social security numbers of all
14 but 33 staffing agency class members;

15 **WHEREAS**, Defendant has repeatedly attempted to obtain the mailing addresses and social
16 security numbers of the remaining 33 staffing agency class members from their respective staffing
17 agencies;

18 **WHEREAS**, the approved settlement agreement between the Parties and the Court’s
19 preliminary approval order call for class members to be given 60 days to respond and/or object to
20 the class notice and less than 60 days remain before the scheduled final approval hearing; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Parties request additional time to obtain and forward to the settlement
22 administrator the social security numbers and mailing addresses for the remaining 33 employees
23 while also providing class members sufficient notice of the class action settlement.

24 The Parties jointly request and stipulate as follows:

- 25 1. The final approval hearing of the class action settlement is continued from **June 24,**
26 **2026 to August 26, 2026**, or as soon thereafter as the Court may set; and


