1           **TO THE COURT, TO ALL PARTIES, AND TO THEIR RESPECTIVE**  
2 **ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:**

3           WHEREAS, on August 11, 2023, the Court granted preliminary approval of the class  
4 action settlement between Plaintiff Teri Flores (“Plaintiff”) and Janesri De Silva M.D., a  
5 Professional Corp. (“Defendant”) (collectively, the “Parties”);

6           WHEREAS, at the August 11, 2023 hearing, the Court set a deadline for delivery of the  
7 class list to the Settlement Administrator for September 1, 2023 and additional deadlines based on  
8 the delivery of the class list;

9           WHEREAS, Defendant failed to produce the class data to the Settlement Administrator by  
10 September 1, 2023;

11           WHEREAS, the failure to produce the class data was a result of, among other things, a  
12 deterioration of the attorney-client relationship between Defendants and their former counsel of  
13 record, Offit Kurman;

14           WHEREAS, new counsel for Defendants substituted into the case on December 4, 2023,  
15 and are working with Defendants to finalize the class list;

16           WHEREAS, in light of the delay, the Parties request the delivery of the class list and all  
17 related deadlines be continued to allow for time to mail the class list and for Plaintiff to prepare her  
18 motion.

20           **THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED** by and between the attorneys for the  
21 Parties that:


22           The Final Approval Hearing and related deadlines shall be continued as follows:

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- 1 4) Plaintiff must file her motion and request for attorneys' fees no later than February 29,
