2 **TO ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:**

3 On March 25, 2024, the Court entered an Order which granted Plaintiff's Motion for
4 Preliminary Approval of Class and PAGA Action Settlement, granted conditional class certification,
5 approved the format of the Class Notice, and set a Final Approval Hearing (the "Preliminary
6 Approval Order"), thereby preliminarily approving a settlement of the above-entitled action (the
7 "Action") that was reached between Plaintiff Victor Wardell-Pavlovich ("Plaintiff") and Defendant
8 Eastgate Petroleum, LLC ("Defendant") (together with Plaintiff, the "Parties"), in accordance with
9 the Parties' Class Action and PAGA Settlement Agreement and Class Notice (the "Settlement"). The
10 Settlement was attached as **Exhibit 1** to the Declaration of Kane Moon in Support of Plaintiff's
11 Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Action Settlement that was filed on January 11, 2024.

12 The Court has entered an Order granting final approval of the Parties' Settlement (the "Final
13 Approval Order"). The Court now has before it a [Proposed] Judgment.

14 The Court, having entered a Final Approval Order in this Action, and good cause appearing,

15 **HEREBY ADJUDGES AND DECREES AS FOLLOWS:**

16 1. The Court, for purposes of this Judgment, incorporates and adopts all terms and
17 definitions as set forth in the Settlement.

18 2. The Court enters Judgment as follows: Plaintiff, Class Counsel, Allegedly Aggrieved
19 Employees, the California Labor and Workforce Development Agency, and the Administrator shall
20 take nothing from Defendant except as expressly set forth in the Final Approval Order and according
21 to the terms of the Settlement.

22 3. The Parties shall bear their own respective attorneys' fees and costs, except as
23 otherwise provided for in the Settlement and approved by the Court.

24 4. This Judgment and the concurrently filed Final Approval Order are intended to be a
25 final disposition of the Action in its entirety and are intended to be immediately appealable.

26 5. Notwithstanding the finality of this Judgment, pursuant to California Code of Civil
27 Procedure section 664.6, the Court shall retain continuing jurisdiction over the Parties, Action, and
28 the Settlement solely for purposes of (i) enforcing this Settlement and/or Judgment, (ii) addressing

1 settlement administration matters, and (iii) addressing such post-Judgment matters as are permitted
2 by law.

3 **IT IS SO ADJUDGED.**
