1 **[PROPOSED] JUDGMENT**

2 1. In accordance with, and for the reasons stated in the Court's Order Granting Plaintiff's
3 Unopposed Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and PAGA Settlement,
4 Judgment shall be entered in the above-captioned case whereby Plaintiff LAURA SANCHEZ in
5 Case No. 21STCV16971 ("Plaintiff") and all Class Members and Aggrieved Employees shall take
6 nothing from Defendant PIAZZA FAMILY RESTAURANTS, INC. ("Defendant") except as
7 expressly set forth in the STIPULATION AND SETTLEMENT OF CLASS ACTION AND
8 PAGA CLAIMS ("Settlement").

9 2. Solely for purposes of effectuating the Settlement, this Court has certified a Class
10 defined as "all current and former hourly-paid or non-exempt employees of Defendant within
11 the state of California at any time during the Class Period of May 5, 2017, through February
12 11, 2022."

13 3. The Aggrieved Employees are defined as "all current and former hourly-paid or
14 non-exempt employees of Defendant within the state of California at any time during the
15 PAGA Period of May 5, 2020, through February 11, 2022."

16 4. Upon the date that Defendant provide the Settlement Administrator with the Gross
17 Settlement Amount, Plaintiff and Participating Class Members will release Defendant Piazza
18 Family Restaurants, Inc. and its past, present and/or future, direct and/or indirect, officers,
19 directors, members, managers, employees, agents, representatives, attorneys, insurers,
20 partners, investors, shareholders, administrators, parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates,
21 divisions, predecessors, successors, assigns, and joint venturers ("Released Parties") from all
22 claims under federal, state or local law, arising out of the facts, claims, and theories expressly
23 pleaded in the Operative Complaint, or reasonably could have been alleged based on the facts
24 and legal theories contained in the Operative Complaint, including all of the following claims
25 for relief: (i) failure to pay all regular rate wages, minimum wages, and overtime wages due;
26 (ii) failure to pay paid sick leave; (iii) failure to provide compliant meal periods; (iv) failure
27 to provide compliant rest breaks; (v) failure to timely pay wages during employment; (vi)
28 failure to provide complete, accurate wage statements; (vii) failure to pay wages timely at

1 time of termination or resignation; (viii) failure to reimburse or indemnify necessary business
2 expenses; and (ix) unfair business practices that could have been premised on the claims,
3 causes of action or legal theories of relief described above or any of the claims, causes of
4 action or legal theories of relief pleaded in the operative complaint. ("Released Class
5 Claims"). This release applies to the Class Period of May 5, 2017, through February 11, 2022.

6 5. In addition to the release set forth above, upon Defendant providing the Gross
7 Settlement Amount to the Settlement Administrator, Plaintiff and all Aggrieved Employees shall
8 be deemed to have released the Released Parties of any and all claims and/or causes of action
9 under PAGA which are based upon the facts, claims and theories expressly pleaded in the
10 Operative Complaint and/or any facts, claims, or theories set forth in the LWDA Notice against
11 Defendant dated May 4, 2021; and arising at any time during the PAGA Period of May 5, 2020,
12 through February 11, 2022.

13 6. To date, no individual timely opted out of the Settlement. Therefore Plaintiff, all
14 Class Members, and all Aggrieved Employees, are bound by the terms of this Judgment.

15 7. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters related to the
16 of, or related to the subject matter of the lawsuit, including but not limited to all matters related to
17 the Settlement and the determination of all controversies relating thereto.

18 8. Plaintiff shall give notice of this Judgment to Class Members, and Aggrieved
19 Employees, pursuant to rule 3.771 of the California Rules of Court, by posting an electronic copy
20 of the Judgment on the Settlement Administrator's website.

21 9. An OSC Re: Compliance with the this Order and Judgment is set for July 16, 2026
22 at 8:30 am, with a report and Declaration of the Administrator due on July 6, 2026.
