To Whom It May Concern,

The horse 2024 Zagrah(gb) X Om Filly owned by Yvette Gillam (Cambridge Park) was examined on August 29 2025 for an upper airway exam and knee radiographs:

Upper airway exam: Moderate pharyngeal lymphoid hyperplasia present. Nasal passages, nasopharnx, epiglottis, arytenoids, soft palate and proximal trachea are all normal. Pharyngeal lymphoid hyperplasia is a common, often normal response in young horses. It generally resolves with growth and maturity, does not require treatment and is not a significant concern at this time.

Knee (carpal) radiographs: Lateral and DP views of both knees were taken. Right front carpal radiographs are within normal limits. Left front carpal radiographs have mild lipping at the caudal aspect of the physis of the distal radius and are otherwise within normal limits. There are no clinical signs associated with these mild changes at this time and no significant angular limb deformity. Radiographically, this generally resolves with growth and maturity and does not require treatment at this time.
