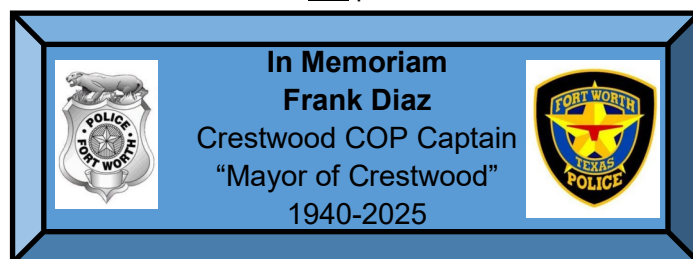

The City of Fort Worth wants to remind us:

Trash, recycle and lawn bins are to be removed from view the day after refuse pickup. For us that would be by Thursday each week. They plan to start issuing citations in the coming months. Thank you!

COPS Beat Crestwood's new Neighborhood Patrol Officer, **Officer Jason Back**, wants to bring policing **back** to the neighborhood by getting to know residents, listening to their concerns, and developing a rapport with neighbors that would allow him to text email alerts and other information to residents. Frank thought this a grand idea. But Officer Back wants to interact with you directly. To that end Officer Back would ask you send him your name, email address and phone number. He'd be very interested in meeting you for a cup of coffee and a chat if you have the time. You can arrange to meet, or merely send your information to Officer Back to Jason.back@fortworthtexas.gov. His cell is 682-346-5862. If you worry that this is an invasion of your privacy then don't do it. If Officer Back really needed your information he could get it anyway, but he's really trying to be a neighborhood resource and wanting to meet his clients. Also, our neighborhood security, as Frank proved, depends upon a strong relationship with our FWPD, and our NPO is the place to start.
