Crestwood Crime Patrol

The *Crestwood Crime Patrol* is the primary branch of the Crestwood Association's *Citizens on Patrol / Security* committee. The work of the Patrol enhances the efforts of that committee's Security branch to further reduce and prevent crime in the neighborhood.

Since 1988, volunteers have strengthened traditional crime watch efforts in Crestwood, lending extra eyes and ears to the Police Department and deterring crime by patrolling in their cars, on bicycles, and on foot. In 1991, the Patrol joined the City of Fort Worth Police Department's *Code Blue: Citizens on Patrol* program.

The Patrol works closely with the Neighborhood Police Officer (NPO), who is the direct liaison between the Fort Worth Police Department and the residents of Crestwood. The Patrol also frequently engages service and support from all number of city departments that contribute to the maintenance of a safe neighborhood environment.

The personal safety of its members is paramount; those on patrol do not carry weapons or confront anyone and they stay in touch with a patrol-base volunteer throughout their shift. The 'job' is simply to observe and report, calling for emergency services or non-emergency response as necessary.

Any adult resident of Crestwood can apply for membership in the Crestwood Crime Patrol. More volunteers are always needed. For information contact Frank Diaz at 817-909-0947.
