The Crestwood Crime Patrol is an auxiliary committee of the Crestwood Association, operating a citizen-volunteer organization to enhance neighborhood security and in cooperation with the Association's Security Committee, which investigates and recommends ways to increase security and reduce crime.

Since 1988, these volunteers have strengthened traditional Crime Watch efforts in Crestwood, lending extra eyes and ears to the Police Department and deterring crime by patrolling in their cars, on bicycles, and on foot. In 1991, the Patrol joined the City of Fort Worth Police Department's *Code Blue: Citizens on Patrol* program.

The Patrol works closely with the Neighborhood Police Officer (NPO), who is the liaison between the Fort Worth Police Department and the residents of Crestwood. The Patrol also frequently engages service and support from all number of city departments that contribute to the maintenance of a safe neighborhood environment.

The personal safety of its members is paramount; those on patrol do not carry weapons or confront anyone and they stay in touch with a patrol-base volunteer throughout their shift. The 'job' is simply to observe and report, calling for emergency services or non-emergency response as necessary.
