IMPORTANT

Monthly gathering: At least one parent or responsible adult participates with the child each month. Parent formation is practical, Catholic, and offered in English and Spanish. Children receive age appropriate formation while parents receive the materials and preparation needed for the weeks at home. Home formation: Parents teach the assigned weekly lessons, pray with their children, connect the lessons with Sunday Mass, and return completed work at the next gathering.
