



Welcome to lesson 4 of Sapere Aude!

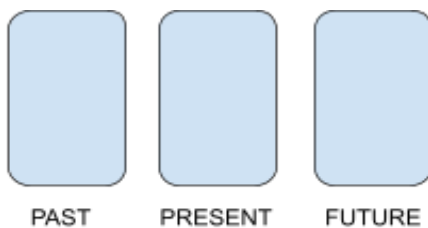
I'm so happy that our group is growing and, well, what a fantastic group you all are!

RUNES 3 -

Now, hopefully, you'll have been doing some independent research this last few weeks regarding the runes and their meanings... but, I realise how much life can get in the way sometimes, so I'll make sure we have some meanings floating about.

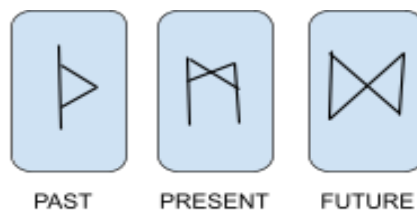
So, first we'll begin with a three rune reading – Focus on your life and ask the fates to give you guidance... Now, with that question in mind, close your eyes and draw three runes from the bag at random, these represent your past, your present, and your future.



The first draw will be your past, the second, the present, and the third, the future.

Now, don't be too literal. When casting and interpreting, remember to be open.

For example, the draw:



The past rune is Thurisaz (thoo-reesaws)
The present is Mannaz (maw-nawz)
The future is Dagaz (tha-gawz / Th-ow-gawz)

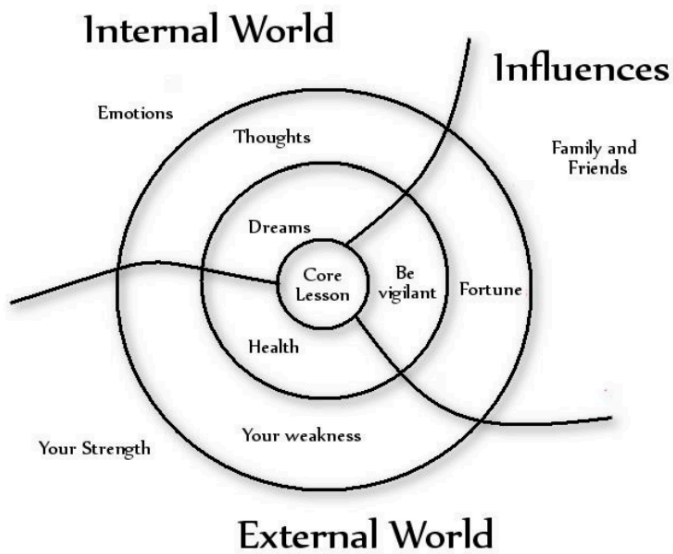
Using the charts - what do you think this

In many magical writings, witches and wise ones have their own alphabets to help to keep the magic hidden. This week I'll share one type of alphabet used for many years, The Theban Alphabet, also known as, The Runes of Honorius, or The Witches Alphabet.
