Criteria

Citizen of the Year

- Has made a significant contribution to our Community.
- Open to persons 25 years and older.

Young Citizen of the Year

- Has made a significant contribution to our Community.
- Open to persons under the age of 25 years.
- This is not a sporting award, however, may be won by a junior citizen who has
 made a significant contribution to our sporting Community through volunteering,
 rather than participating.

Services to Sport Award

- Has made a significant contribution in a voluntary capacity to the sport of their choice.
- Open to all age groups.
- Has outstanding achievements in sport.
- Displays an incredible sense of sportsmanship.

Community Group of the Year

- A group who has made a significant contribution to our community
- Can be a volunteer organisation, a committee, group, sporting team, association, service club or not for profit.

Sports Star of the Year

- Open to persons 20 years and under.
- A person who has shown their ability to play their chosen sport and shown leadership, encouragement and caring to their follow players and team.

Young Artist of the Year

- Open to persons 15 years and under.
- Has designed an A3 poster for the 2027 Australia Day showing the reason we celebrate this great National Day.

The poster will be used as advertising for Taree Australia Day Celebration 26th January 2027on the River Stage in Queen Elizabeth Park .

The poster will be reproduced and displayed in shop windows and on social media.

The winner will receive a \$150.00 donated by Friends of the Manning Regional Art Gallery

Hero of the Year

- Any nominations received after 5.00pm Tuesday 9th December 2025 will not be considered for the Awards.
- Additional information cannot be provided after the closing date and time, unless it is a correction.
- All nominees will be notified after the closing date, advising that they have been nominated. All Nominees and Nominators will be invited to attend the 2026 Taree Combined Service Clubs Australia Day Ceremony at 8:30am on 26th January 2026.
- The winners will be announced on Australia Day at the 2026 Taree Combined Service Clubs Australia Day Ceremony, which will be held in Queen Elizabeth Park Friday 26th January 2026 commencing at 8:30am.

Eligibility

- Nominees must reside in the Manning Valley to be eligible across all award categories.
- Nominees must be Australian Citizens.
- Nominees must be undertaking their contributions in voluntary roles. Persons should not be nominated for positions in which they are paid or have financial interest.
- Nominees should have made an exceptional contribution to our Community in the last 12-month period (note: this period may be longer).
- All nominations must include all parts of the nomination criteria.
- Anonymous nominations cannot be accepted.
- The selection committee may request additional information about the nominated person or group.
