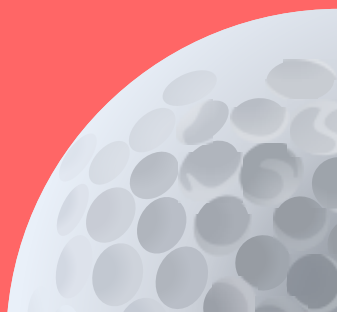

RESPONSIBILITIES OF PLAYERS AND CONDITIONS

The player is responsible for knowing the conditions of play for a competition before starting in that competition.

The player is responsible for their card ensuring scores are correct and required signature are present before completion.

Players should be ready to play 15 minutes before a scheduled starting time.

Players must observe course etiquette and avoid slow play.

The Match Committee may vary the programme if necessary.

All competitions shall be played according to the Rules of Golf, Local Rules and specific conditions if listed. To ensure that all players enjoy all competitions, the following conditions apply to every event:

STARTERS are in charge and are in **control of the order of play**. The starter has the right to ask you to move into another group to keep the field of the day moving.

READY GOLF – On the tee, the first player ready to play should assume the honour as a general rule. Cards can be marked after hit-off. Between the tee and green, players should move to their ball and hit when safe to do so. On the green, players should putt out unless they will damage or stand on someone's line of play.

LOST BALL – Should a ball appear to be lost; the group concerned should call the following group through before beginning to search. Search time is then limited to 3 minutes.

SLOW PLAY – The lowest marker in any group is deemed responsible for the conduct and etiquette of the group, and to see that the group maintains their position in the competition field. Any group losing one clear hole on the group ahead, without justifiable reason, could be subject to penalty for slow play.

DRESS REGULATIONS – As displayed on the various notice boards, ladies must be neatly and correctly attired.

SCORE CARDS – On completion of the round, the cards must be returned to the markers desk as soon as possible after the score has been entered into the computer. Care should be taken to enter the score correctly into the computer. Click SAVE SCORE to finalise.....

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES – are now permitted in all local events and Golf NSW events unless specifically prohibited in the conditions of a particular competition.

MOBILE PHONES SHOULD BE TURNED OFF OR KEPT IN SILENT MODE.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

Seasonal Stableford	Over 6 rounds – the best 4 scores in each division is the winner
Monthly Medal	Over 7 days; 4 played on stroke days and 3 played on Stableford days. Played over the field. Saturday competition has 3 days: 2 stroke and 1 Stableford round
District Medal	District medal played at nominated course, 3 divisions
GNSW Medal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - over 6 days – played on stroke days – played in divisions - lowest total of best 3 from the 6 nett scores - cost \$5 must be paid to be eligible to represent the club within the district for medal playoff - winner of district then goes to course in Sydney for Final
Club Medal	Over 4 days – graded draw 3 best nett scores over the field is the winner
Club Championship	Over 3 days – graded draw – 3 rd round is seeded – nett and gross winners
Putting	Usually held the same day as GNSW Medal. Lowest 4 rounds of the 6 days in each division
Four Pointers	Only recorded on Stableford days – must be recorded anywhere on the score card. End of year trophy in each division
Birdie Competition	All birdies must be recorded anywhere on the score card; there is a prize at the end of the year for most birdies in each division

Gobbler Competition	all gobblers must be recorded anywhere on the score card and "G" written beside the hole; there is a prize at the end of the year for the most gobblers in each division.
3's	All 3's must be recorded anywhere on the score card End of year trophy in each division
5 Pointers	All 5's must be recorded anywhere on the score card
Medals of Medals	all Monthly Medal winners play off at the end of the year. (Wed/Sat – best nett score)
Mabel McKenzie	a stroke round held in March – No Charge – Winner in each division
Keno Ambrose	Need to nominate your team and pay nomination fee on the day of the event in your club; winning team goes to play on a nominated course in the district and winner on that day goes to Bonville Golf Club to play in the final
Point-score	in each division, on individual games – all starters get 1 point; winner gets 4 points, 2 nd gets 3 points, 3 rd gets 2 points
VWGA Country Championships	Gross and Nett winners in each division. Held in April for Wednesday and Saturday competitions
COURSE RECORD	Can only be achieved on Stroke round days. With no preferred lies and tee markers must be in correct position as per GNSW

20 MUST KNOW RULES OF GOLF CHANGES FOR 2019

1. Drop from knee height (NOT shoulder height)
2. Measure the area to drop in with the longest club in your bag (except a putter)
3. Drop in and play from the relief area.
4. When dropping back-on-the-line, your ball cannot be played from nearer the hole than your chosen reference point.
5. Time to search – 3 minutes (NOT 5 minutes)
6. If you accidentally move your ball when searching for it, replace it without penalty.
7. No penalty for a double hit – it only counts as one stroke.
8. No penalty if your ball hits you or your equipment accidentally after a stroke
9. No penalty if your ball strikes the flagstick when you have chosen to leave it in the hole.
10. Spike mark and other shoe damage on the putting green can be repaired.
11. Ball accidentally moved on putting green – no penalty and replace.
12. Ball marked, lifted and replaced on putting green is moved by wind to another position –replace ball on the original spot.
13. Penalty areas replace water hazards, and you can move loose impediments, ground your club and take practice swings in penalty areas without penalty, just as you can on the fairway or in the rough
14. You can't take relief from a penalty area unless you are at least 95% certain your ball is in the penalty area.
15. In bunkers you can move loose impediments

16. In bunkers you cannot touch the sand with your club in the area right in front of or right behind your ball, during your backswing or in taking practice swings.
17. Free relief is allowed if your ball is embedded on the fairway or in the rough (but “embedded” means that part of your ball is below the level of the ground)
18. Unplayable ball in bunker – extra option to drop outside the bunker for 2 penalty strokes.
19. You cannot have your caddie or your partner standing behind you once you begin taking your stance.
20. Pace of Play - it is recommended that you take no longer than 40 seconds to make a stroke (and usually you should be able to play more quickly than that) and Ready Golf in stroke play is encouraged.

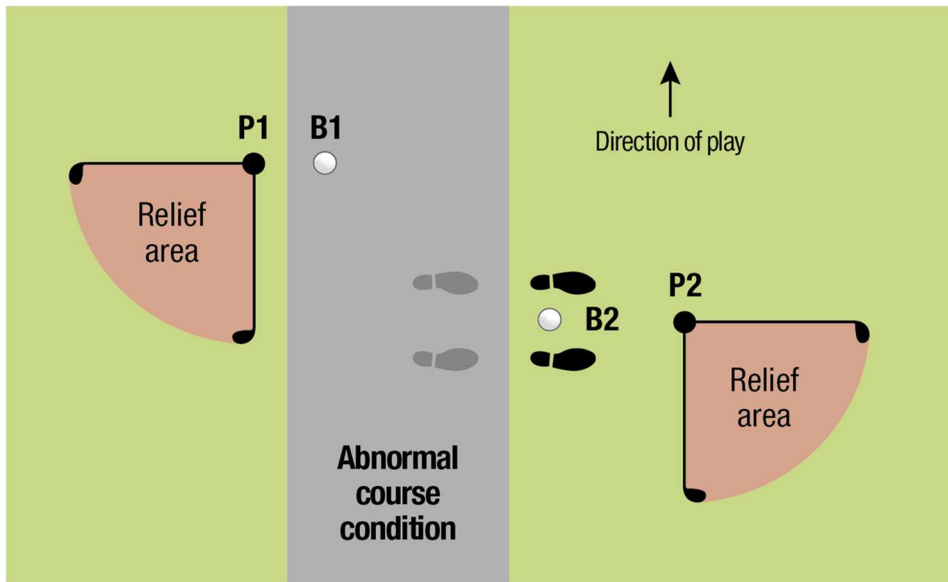


RULINGS

GUR (Ground Under Repair or Abnormal Course Condition)

When Relief Is Allowed - Humps (holes 10; 11 & 12)

You get relief from ground under repair when your **ball, stance or intended swing** is interfered with by the area. (rule 16.1)



From the picture **FREE** relief is allowed:

- B1 when the ball touches or lies in or on the condition
- B2 condition interferes with your intended stance or swing

The nearest point of relief: (player is right-handed)

- B1 the nearest point of relief is P1 and is very close to the condition
- B2 the nearest point of relief is P2 and is farther from the condition as full relief from the GUR is taken.

In other words:

- If your ball lies on the GUR – free relief is allowed
- If your ball **ISN'T** on or in the GUR but your stance is – free relief is allowed
- And please remember it is not mandatory to drop from our GUR, you have the option to play the ball as it lies. Some Clubs may make it mandatory but Club Taree has not.

AMERICAN FOURSOMES

Both players play tee shots at each hole and then play **second shot** with their partner's ball. One ball is then chosen and play proceeds as in Foursomes. If Player B hits the second shot with selected ball, Player A hits the next shot and players hit alternately until the hole is completed

CANADIAN FOURSOMES

This event is played as per Foursomes, except both players play tee shots at every hole and then continue with whichever ball they nominate. If Player A has hit the nominated ball off the tee, Player B hits the second shot. Play continues until the ball is holed.

2 STROKE CANADIAN

Both partners hit off the tee and the second shot is played with their own ball. One ball is then selected for subsequent play and is played alternately during the play of each hole.

PAR

Played as a Stableford event, but scoring is as follows: If you have a score of **3/2** that is a ■, **2/3** is a +, or **5/2** is a ■ and **4/3** +. Two points is always a ■ and three or better is always + and anything below a 2 is a – (minus).

SPLIT SIX

This is a Stableford event played with a partner.

First 6 holes (1-6) the **best** score of the 2 is **counted**

The next 6 holes (7-12) the **both** scores are **counted**

The next 6 holes (13-18) the **both** scores are **multiplied**

FOURSOMES

Partners use **one** ball. The partners hit off alternately from the tee, e.g. one hits off odd numbered tees and her partner hits off even numbered tees and thereafter hit the ball alternately during the play of each hole.

AMBROSE DROP OUT

All competitors tee off and then select the best shot. The competitor whose shot is chosen drops out for the next shot. This routine is repeated for the next shot when the best shot maker drops out and the original drop out comes back in. This continues until the ball reaches the green when **all** competitors can putt if necessary

PREVENTING SLOW PLAY

Be ready on the first and stand.

With ball on the tee and club in hand

On the next tee, ***saving time*** is not hard.

One drives off and the other marks the card.

Do not leave your buggy in the way.

Or those behind you must wait to play.

Keep up with players ahead of you.

Losing a hole is strictly taboo.

Lost a ball? Not a clue?

Players behind you, must call through.

In stableford if you can't score

Pick up your ball and putt no more.

If slow coach you must stay

Then please play later in the day.....
