PASTORAL ADDRESS - Rev. Dr. Sarah Taylor Peck

VISION FOR SPORTS MINISTRY - Melanie Karrick

Mike Lilien, Broadway member, first spoke with Darren Day in 2023, with the idea to make a usable gym a reality and a revenue stream for Broadway. Our current floor is not suitable for sports play, but a new floor costing approximately \$86,400 should bring in revenue of \$78,000 - \$146,000 over five years, says Mike. The Property Committee and Executive Committee agreed to move forward with gathering information. No contract has been signed and there are details to coordinate through the Executive Committee. In addition to building character traits in the youth, an added bonus could be that players and parents become acquainted with Broadway and each other and make Broadway their home. Since sharing the Sports Ministry Vision at the June 23 Board meeting, a number of members have already committed a total of over half of the cost. Those committed include: Mike Lilien, Chris Peck, Bob and Candy Whittet, Guy Adams and Martha Jolly, Ken Askren, Melanie Karrick, Audie Spieler and Scott Gray, for a total of \$46,000.
