Discipleship is the process by which we deepen our faith and grow in Christ. Each of us is at our own unique place in this process. We bring our questions, curiosities, hesitations and excitement as we navigate our spiritual journey. At Broadway, we've developed an array of classes, groups, and resources to help you grow in your own process of spiritual discovery.

Groups and classes come in a variety of shapes and sizes with new offerings added each season. Some meet weekly or bi-weekly. Others meet monthly or bi-monthly. Some are fellowship oriented while others focus on study, prayer, service, or a shared interest.

Core classes are offered several times throughout the year and are great places to start learning about our congregation, denomination, and your place in the story. Sunday school classes, seasonal series, and other small groups explore a variety of topics ranging from scripture, prayer, to contemporary theological/social issues. Small groups provide space for people to share faith and life together as they foster community and relational connection that makes us church.
