The senior classroom has been busy continuing to build skills across all learning areas. In literacy, students have been learning new phonics sounds, improving their handwriting, and building confidence when speaking in front of their classmates through our daily morning news sessions.

In reading, we have continued exploring *The First Scientists* while learning about the structure and features of information reports. In P.E., students are continuing to develop the skills and knowledge needed to participate in a variety of sports.

We are also currently completing assessments across several learning areas. The students have been doing a terrific job staying focused, working hard, and always trying their best. We are very proud of the effort and determination they are showing.

As we near the end of term our students are putting the final touches on their information texts and preparing for their presentations. Students have had the opportunity to research their own topics and present their information in whatever form they wish.

Grade F-1 Classroom

In writing the children have been learning about the structure of a narrative and have been identifying the beginning, middle and end of a story. They have drawn images to show their knowledge and have also written words and sentences to describe their choices. This week we have added depth to our knowledge of narratives by learning about the elements: character, setting, problem, feeling, action and ending. Children retold a story verbally before writing and/or drawing about each part of the story.

In reading, the preps have finished learning their stage 2 sounds and the grade ones have finished their stage 6 sounds. We have been working hard on heart words, speed words, handwriting and matching the correct grapheme to the phoneme.

In maths, we have been focusing on addition and we are moving into subtraction using manipulatives. We have been using songs and games to help with counting to 20 and beyond.

This also allows us to plan our classrooms, staffing and transition activities, and ensures your child has the best start to school.
