Grade F-1 Classroom

This week in our classroom, the Prep students are exploring the **j** and **u** sounds in phonics and learning **positional language** to give directions in maths. Meanwhile, the Year One students are mastering the **igh**, **-y**, and **ie** graphemes, practicing **skip counting** by 2s, 5s, and 10s, and finding **missing numbers** in sequences.

In writing and inquiry, all students are discovering amazing **Australian animals** and building skills to write a strong **descriptive paragraph**. They use rich words to describe animal features, habitats, and daily habits in their informational writing projects.

We have also explored two book week picture books, *Frogs* and *Bob and Dob*. The children had some powerful discussions and created some beautiful artwork with sentences to match.

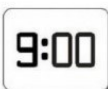
EVERY MINUTE COUNTS ...
