
The whole school have been working really hard on creating some fabulous artworks to display down the Barkly Street from October 16th.

F-2 CLASSROOM

This week we have begun practising our play for the concert. Students chose their parts in the play and they have been reading through their lines and learning them as a class. Students are excited about the play and cannot wait to show you.

We have been learning about numbers this week and have been using estimation and counting strategies trying to get 100 pieces of macaroni pasta for Grandma's Soup recipe. Students have been engaged with this learning and trying to get exactly 100 pieces of macaroni, they are developing efficient counting strategies to quickly count their handfuls of pasta.

In art this week both classes enjoyed making some camo-butterflies. Some butterflies were more camouflaged than others but check out some of the photos and see if you can see the butterflies (some photos will have more than one butterfly).



3-6 CLASSROOM

A big welcome back to the 3-6 class. We have hit the ground running and jumped straight into some measurement and geometry activities in our maths lessons, diving deep into volume. The students have been using different objects to measure items around the classroom. One of the activities was to find the volume of a milk carton. One group used 20c pieces, another used MAB blocks and the last group used 6-sided dice. At the end of the lesson the groups had a moment to share their findings with the rest of the class.



This term in our literacy blocks, we have begun a new unit on Rivers of the World. This is a geographical Information unit full of fun facts of our earth's land and water sources.

The roles for the class play have been dealt! The 3-6 class is revved and ready to begin preparation for their performance at the end of the year. Already the students are exchanging ideas and discussing possibilities for the performance night.
