Fences Require the Following:

Where a fence is within 10 feet of the property line of an abutting property, one of the following is required:

- A survey of the site prepared by a licensed surveyor, **OR**
- A notarized letter from each neighbor with property near the proposed fence or wall stating they do not object.

(a template will be provided to you)

Please Note:

- Fence posts may exceed the maximum height of the fence by **up to one (1) foot.**
- For fencing purposes only, corner lots are considered to have two front yards.
- Fences shall not exceed six **(6)** feet in height in residential districts in the rear and side yards. Fencing shall not exceed four **(4)** feet in height in the front yard.
